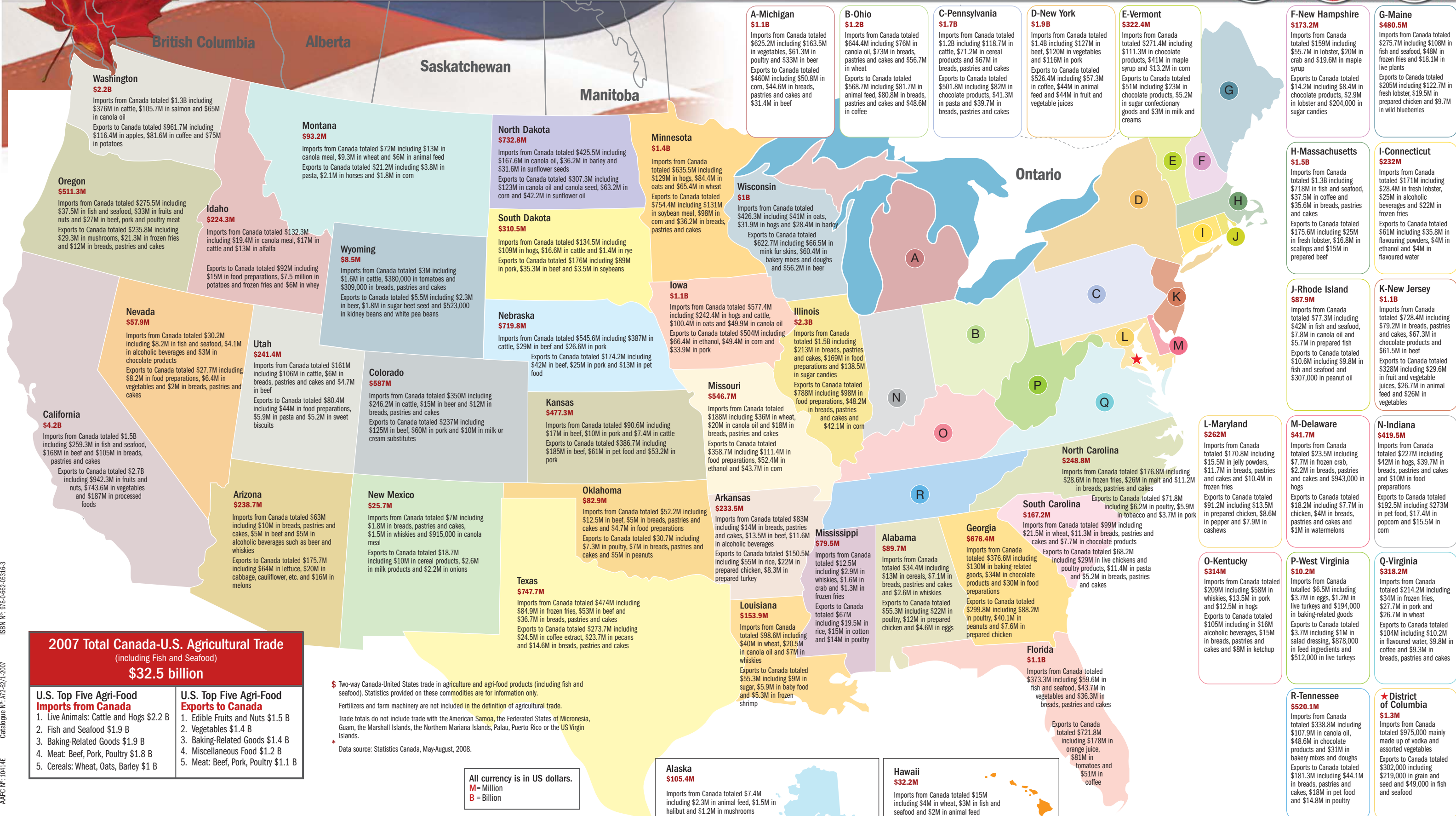


# Canada: We're on your map
