

URMULE UPDATE

User Requested Minor Use Label Expansion (URMULE) Registrations November 20-December 31, 1997

The URMULE Update provides timely information on the latest proposals for minor use label expansion of pesticides that have been evaluated and accepted for registration.

For the following pesticides, a Certificate of Registration has been issued based on a Supplemental Label, making the use legal. Registrants are required to add the new use to the full product label at the next printing. Provincial authorities, in publishing recommendations on the use of pesticides, may incorporate such acceptable uses in the knowledge that they meet the requirements of the *Pest Control Products Act*.

Horticulture Crops and Products

Tree Fruits

2,4-D Amine (2,4-D Amine 600 - IPCO) registration number 17511 for broadleaf weed control on bearing apple, peach, pear, plum, apricot and sweet and sour cherry.

Vegetables

Bacillus thuringiensis (Foray 48BA - Abbott), registration number 24978 for the control of Cabbage Looper on Greenhouse peppers, cucumbers, tomatoes and lettuce.

Bacillus thuringiensis (Dipel WP - Abbott), registration number 11252 for the control of Diamondback moth, Cabbage Looper and Imported cabbage Worm on Chinese cabbage, Bok Choy, Chinese broccoli and Asian radish.

Grasses Grown for Seed

Quizalofop-ethyl (Assure herbicide - Dupont), registration number 22111 for quackgrass and grassy weed control in Established Creeping Red Fescue grown for Seed production.

Others

Etridiazole (**Truban - Scott Sierra**), registration number 11460 for Pythium Crown and Root Rot control on golf greens and commercial turfgrass production.

Quinclorac (Accord herbicide - BASF), registration number 25118 for postemergent control of green foxtail in Canaryseed.
