# User Requested Minor Use Label Expansion Program Registrations for April 13 - July 9, 1999

The User Requested Minor Use Label Expansion (URMULE) Update provides timely information on the latest proposals for minor use label expansion of pesticides that have been evaluated and accepted for registration.

For the following pesticides, a Certificate of Registration has been issued based on a Supplemental Label, making the use legal. Registrants are required to add the new use to the full product label at the next printing. Provincial authorities, in publishing recommendations on the use of agricultural chemicals, may incorporate such acceptable uses in the knowledge that they meet the requirements of the Pest Control Products Act.

You must consult the product label as the ultimate authority on whether or not the product can be used to control a specific pest on a specific site as the list is subject to change with time.

**s-Metolachlor** (Dual Magnum - Novartis), registration number 25728 for weed control in transplanted cabbage, cauliflower and broccoli.

**Clethodim** (Select - Tomen Corp), registration number 22625 for the control of labelled weeds on dry onions.

**Metribuzin** (Sencor DF - Bayer), registration number 17242 for scentless chamomile control in processing carrots (Atlantic Canada only).

## **Pulse Crops**

**Sethoxydim** (Poast Ultra - BASF), registration number 24835 for the control of labelled weeds on chickpeas.

#### Fruit

**Cyprodinil** (Vanguard 75WG - Novartis) registration number 25509, for Botrytis Bunch Rot control in grapes

# Herbs/Spices

**Terbacil** (Sinbar - DuPont), registration number 10628, for the control of labelled weeds on spearmint and peppermint.

# Forestry

**Glyphosate** (Vision - Monsanto), registration number 19899, for the control of Ericaceous species (e.g., Kalmia) for forestry site preparation.

**Bacillus thuringiensis** (Foray 76B - Abbott Laboratories) registration number 22403, for the control of White Marked Tussock Moth

in forests/woodlots.

## Other

**Deltamethrin** (Decis 5EC - AgrEvo) registration number 22478, for grasshopper control in Eastern Canada on pastures, rangelands and rights-of-way.
