User Requested Minor Use Label Expansion Program Registrations from July 10 to August 31, 1999

The User Requested Minor Use Label Expansion (URMULE) Update provides timely information on the latest proposals for minor use label expansion of pesticides that have been evaluated and accepted for registration.

For the following pesticides, a Certificate of Registration has been issued based on a Supplemental Label, making the use legal. Registrants are required to add the new use to the full product label at the next printing. Provincial authorities, in publishing recommendations on the use of agricultural chemicals, may incorporate such acceptable uses in the knowledge that they meet the requirements of the *Pest Control Products Act*.

Users must consult the product label as the ultimate authority on whether or not the product can be used to control a specific pest on a specific site, as a product's uses are subject to change.

Imidacloprid (Impower - Plant Products)

Registration number 25658, for the control of aphids and whiteflies on greenhouse tomatoes and cucumbers.

Imidacloprid (Admire 240 - Bayer)

Registration number 24094, for the control of lettuce aphid on lettuce (head and leaf) in British Columbia ONLY.

Imazethapyr (Pursuit - Cyanamid)

Registration number 21537, for the control of weeds on snapbeans.

Thiophanate-methyl (Senator 70WP - Engage)

Registration number 25343, for the control of Cercospora leaf spot on sugarbeets.

Tree Fruit

Propiconazole (Topas 250E - Engage)

Registration number 24030, for the control of brown rot blossom blight and fruit brown rot on peach, nectarine, plum, apricot and sweet and sour cherry.

Fruit

Bentazon (Basagran - BASF)

Registration number 12221, for the control of yellow nutsedge on blueberry.

Grasses

Bromoxynil/MCPA (Buctril M - Rhone-Poulenc)

Registration number 18022, for the control of weeds on established Timothy grown for hay.
