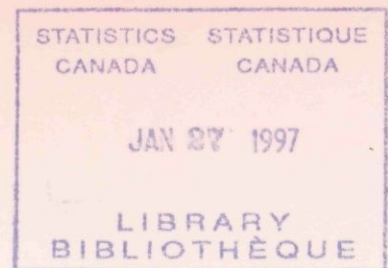

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Training Objectives

- **This training guide consists of a series of exercises and diagrams that will help you to understand the procedures for Phase 2 of the 1996 Reverse Record Check (RRC) Study. You will find that each Section of this guide corresponds to the same Section in the Phase 2 manual, including diagram numbers. Separate exercises will be distributed by your supervisor to reinforce critical aspects of the Phase 2 (Edits and Reworks) training.**
- **The purpose of the exercises is not to test your memory but rather to give you a chance to apply the procedures. Always refer to your procedures manual while doing the training session and make notes at the end of each Section in the manual for your own reference.**
- **Only by performing the actual duties of the operation will you become completely familiar with all aspects of the Phase 2 Reverse Record Check activities. By the end of this training program, you should have a thorough knowledge of the procedures.**
- **During your training, ask for clarification on any of the procedures that are not completely clear to you. It is recommended that you pay close attention to the forms package distributed to you by your supervisor as these will be your tools in the weeks to come.**
- **Rest assured that after the training and during the RRC production, your supervisor will be available for discussing and answering any questions pertaining to your duties.**

Exercise 4 Form H-332R (Rework Form)

A Form H-332R is printed if an address is to be **reworked**. Address data are reprocessed if either the capture Phase 1 data for an address is unresolved or there was no Phase 1 data for an address. Addresses having no Phase 1 data are those where the search areas were not determined by the automated geosearch system and therefore not processed in Phase 1.

A referral operation is undertaken to **confirm or update the SP's address** printed in Section 1 on the Form H-332R using information from the SP's file as well as general and geographic reference materials (if applicable). Read pages 16-22 in your **Phase 2 (Edits and Reworks)** manual. Refer to Forms H-332R from pages 22-31 for personal reference before completing the following questions.
