## **CUSTOMS NOTICE 13-003**

## Increase to the Low Value Shipment (LVS) Threshold for Shipments Imported Into Canada

- 1. This notice announces an increase to the low value shipment (LVS) threshold for the release and accounting of shipments imported into Canada.
- 2. The current LVS threshold has been established by regulations at a value for duty of less than CAD\$1,600. Effective January 8, 2013, the LVS threshold will increase to an estimated value for duty not exceeding CAD\$2,500.
- 3. Paragraphs 6(1)(a) and (b), 7(2.1)(d), 7.1(a)(i), paragraphs 8(a), 8.2(d), 10(a) and (b) and section 10.31 of the *Accounting for Imported Goods and Payment of Duties Regulations* and paragraph 4(c) of the *Fees in Respect of Mail Regulations*, will be amended to reflect this notice and the Canada Border Services Agency publications will be updated.
