## AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$467 MILLION IN 2014 Let's keep a good thing growing!

Arizona exported \$377 million to Canada, including:
$\rightarrow \$ 235 \mathrm{M}$ in vegetables (including $\$ 58 \mathrm{M}$ in peppers)
$\rightarrow \$ 74 \mathrm{M}$ in fruits and nuts (including \$34M in melons)
$\rightarrow$ \$32M in food preparations*
$\rightarrow$ \$9M in beverages
$\rightarrow \$ 9 \mathrm{M}$ in dairy products

Arizona imported $\$ 90$ million from Canada, including:
$\rightarrow \$ 15 \mathrm{M}$ in baked goods
$\rightarrow$ \$12M in canola oil
$\rightarrow \$ 7 \mathrm{M}$ in fresh/frozen meat (including $\$ 5 \mathrm{M}$ in beef)
$\rightarrow \$ 6 \mathrm{M}$ in beverages (including \$4M in whiskies)
$\rightarrow$ \$6M in food preparations*

* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.


## A Strong Partnership in Trade:

- Since 2005, agriculture and agri-food trade between the U.S. and Canada has more than quadrupled, leading to significant changes in trade patterns and resulting in a more integrated North American marketplace.
- The U.S. and, in particular, Arizona has benefited from this strong relationship - with Canada purchasing over \$26B in agriculture and agri-food products from the U.S. in 2014, of which $\$ 377 \mathrm{M}$ came from Arizona.
- Supply chains that cross our shared border are cost-effective and efficient because of the proximity to each other's agricultural inputs and products. For example, Canada is a major supplier of energy and fertilizers, while the U.S. equips Canada with farm machinery and crop protection technologies.
- Access to Canadian cattle, hogs, and oilseeds allows American feedlots, finishers, and crushing plants to run at capacity, supporting U.S. jobs.
