
Indiana exported \$290 million to Canada, including:

- → \$34M in infant food
- → \$24M in non-alcoholic beverages
- → \$23M in corn
- → \$24M in food preparations (including \$10M in microwaveable popcorn)
- → \$19M in fresh/frozen pork

Indiana imported \$379 million from Canada, including:

- → \$57M in breads and pastries
- → \$37M in chocolate products
- → \$35M in canola oil
- → \$30M in corn seeds
- \$29M in malt extract and mixes and doughs

A Strong Partnership in Trade:

Canada purchased \$21 billion in U.S. agriculture and agri-food products in 2012. Indiana benefitted from this strong relationship in 2012 by exporting \$290 million in agriculture and agri-food products to Canada. To help reduce barriers to trade, lower costs and create economic opportunities, the Regulatory Cooperation Council and Beyond the Border Action Plans were released in December 2011. Increased regulatory cooperation will support U.S.-Canada trade in agriculture and agri-food products, contribute to job creation, and provide a greater variety of safe, high-quality food products for consumers.

Trade with Canada = Jobs in Indiana

→ Approximately 162,000 jobs in Indiana depend on trade with Canada.

All currency is in U.S. dollars and based on 2012 data (as of July 2013). All export figures do not include re-export values.

Trade values are approximate and have been rounded where/when appropriate. Fertilizers, farm machinery and seafood are not included in the definition of agriculture and agri-food trade.

Commodity categories are based on the internationally standardized Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System (HS codes).

Wherein a single commodity is 90 percent or more of an HS group, the specific commodity is named.


