

# IOWA-CANADA

**AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$1.6 BILLION IN 2013**

*Let's keep a good thing growing!*



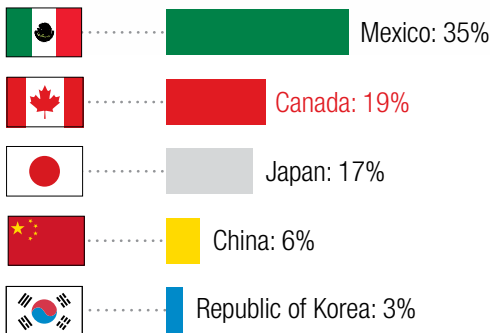
**Iowa exported \$752 million to Canada, including:**

- \$161M in soybean meal
- \$135M in fresh/frozen pork
- \$95M in ethanol
- \$53M in corn
- \$35M in animal/pet feed

**Iowa imported \$859 million from Canada, including:**

- \$224M in canola oil
- \$143M in oats
- \$139M in live animals (including \$121M in hogs)
- \$68M in wheat (including \$54M in durum wheat)
- \$42M in fresh/frozen beef

**A Strong Partnership in Trade:**

Canada-Iowa trade means "making things together." Consider the pork sector. Canadian farmers feed their hogs with soybean meal grown in Iowa and when the hogs are ready, Canadian farmers export them to Iowa for processing and, finally, Iowa sends the finished pork back to Canada. In 2013, Canada imported \$135 million of fresh and frozen pork from Iowa! Iowa processors can count on Canadian producers to keep plants operating at full capacity, and Iowa's expertise in pork processing provides Canadians with a variety of meat products. The story of the pork sector, from feed to farms to processing to market, is a great example of our efficient and effective integrated supply chains.
