
Mississippi exported \$113 million to Canada, including:

- → \$55M in fresh/frozen chicken meat
- → \$18M in rice
- → \$9M in prepared cereals
- → \$6M in sauces and condiments
- → \$5M in breads and pastries (including \$4M in waffles and wafers)

Mississippi imported \$59 million from Canada, including:

- → \$42M in prepared cereals
- → \$6M in alcoholic beverages (including \$3M in whiskey)
- → \$3M in breads and pastries
- → \$2M in fresh/frozen beef
- > \$1M in chocolate products

A Strong Partnership in Trade:

Canada purchased \$21 billion in U.S. agriculture and agri-food products in 2012. Mississippi benefitted from this strong relationship in 2012 by exporting \$113 million in agriculture and agri-food products to Canada. To help reduce barriers to trade, lower costs and create economic opportunities, the Regulatory Cooperation Council and Beyond the Border Action Plans were released in December 2011. Increased regulatory cooperation will support U.S.-Canada trade in agriculture and agri-food products, contribute to job creation, and provide a greater variety of safe, high-quality food products for consumers.

Trade with Canada = Jobs in Mississippi

→ Approximately 68,000 jobs in Mississippi depend on trade with Canada.

All currency is in U.S. dollars and based on 2012 data (as of July 2013). All export figures do not include re-export values.

Trade values are approximate and have been rounded where/when appropriate. Fertilizers, farm machinery and seafood are not included in the definition of agriculture and agri-food trade.

Commodity categories are based on the internationally standardized Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System (HS codes).

Wherein a single commodity is 90 percent or more of an HS group, the specific commodity is named.
