
# Nebraska exported \$336 million to Canada, including:

- → \$142M in fresh/frozen beef
- → \$31M in animal/pet feed (including \$23M in dog and cat food)
- → \$28M in fresh/frozen pork
- → \$27M in salted pork
- → \$25M in prepared cereal grains

# Nebraska imported \$381 million from Canada, including:

- → \$231M in live cattle
- → \$52M in oats
- → \$27M in fresh/frozen beef
- → \$8M in breads and pastries
- → \$5M in canola meal

### A Strong Partnership in Trade:

Nebraska is now wearing the crown as the top state for cattle feeding! Canadian cattle production supports an efficient supply-chain relationship with Nebraska. Nebraska's top ranked cattle and beef industry is valued by Canadians for its animal processing capacity. In 2013, Canada exported \$231 million in cattle to Nebraska, which exported \$142 million in beef to Canada. The high-quality cattle from Canada help Nebraska's processing plants operate at full capacity, while Nebraska's expertise in the meat industry offers an efficient option for processing Canadian livestock. By working together, the beef trade between Nebraska and Canada can thrive and supports jobs and rural communities.
