AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$370 MILLION IN 2014
Let's keep a good thing growing!



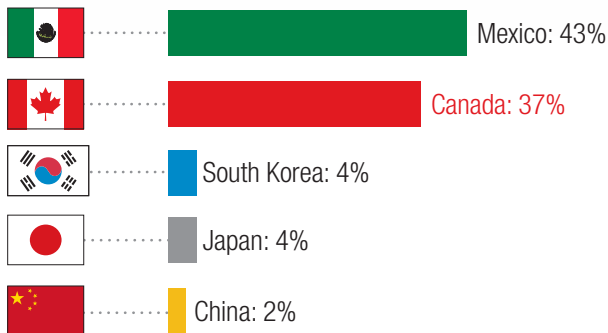
South Dakota exported \$250 million to Canada, including:

- \$150M in animal feed (including \$125M in soybean meal)
- \$75M in fresh/frozen meat (including \$50M in pork)
- \$9M in seeds (including \$3M in sunflower seeds)
- \$6M in soybean oil
- \$3M in grains (including corn and wheat)

South Dakota imported \$120 million from Canada, including:

- \$61M in live animals (including \$47M cattle)
- \$33M in fresh/frozen meat (including \$24M in beef)
- \$7M in oats
- \$6M in seeds (including \$5M in flaxseed)
- \$2M in dried beans and peas

A Strong Partnership in Trade:

Feeding an integrated supply chain! South Dakota agricultural exports complement the Canadian livestock sector, and Canada's livestock exports to South Dakota complement South Dakota's meat processors. In 2014, South Dakota exported \$150M in animal/pet feed including \$125M in soybean meal. These exports allow Canadian farmers to provide excellent nutrition to their livestock —while also bolstering jobs and economic growth in South Dakota. In 2014, Canadian farmers in turn exported \$61M in live animals (including \$47M in cattle) to South Dakota, enabling the state's feedlots to operate at full capacity and further supporting the rural economy in South Dakota. This mutually beneficial trade builds upon efficiencies, advances producers and the economy on both sides of the border, and feeds an ever-strengthening bilateral relationship!
