

# BILATERAL TRADE SUPPORTS INCREASED SECTOR SPECIALIZATION, INTEGRATION AND EFFICIENCIES

Wyoming's world exports of cereal grains has increased by 300% since 2008, and the overwhelming majority of this increase has been purchased by Canada – an unsurprising statistic, given that Wyoming exports more agricultural commodities to Canada than all of its other export markets combined. Our bilateral trading relationship ensures high demand for Wyoming's cereal grains, promotes specialization and efficiencies in the sector and supports further expansion of Wyoming's agriculture industries.

#### TRADE WITH CANADA = JOBS IN WYOMING
