
Colorado exported \$450 million to Canada, including:

- → \$234M in fresh/frozen beef
- → \$80M in fresh/frozen pork
- → \$39M in food preparations (including \$32M in dairy substitutes)
- → \$22M in non-alcoholic beverages (including \$7M in soy beverages)
- → \$18M in breads and pastries

Colorado imported \$168 million from Canada, including:

- → \$45M in live animals (including \$27M in cattle)
- → \$20M in breads and pastries
- → \$16M in vegetables and legumes (including \$9M in peppers)
- → \$10M in canola oil
- → \$10M in wheat (including \$8M in non-durum wheat)

A Strong Partnership in Trade:

Canada is Colorado's top export market for its agricultural products. The integration of Colorado-Canada supply chains is at the heart of our successful trading relationship in agriculture. For example, Canada is the world's 2nd largest exporter of cattle and Colorado is the world's 19th largest exporter of beef. In 2013, Colorado imported \$27 million of Canadian cattle and exported \$234 million of fresh/frozen beef to Canada! The bilateral trading relationship between Colorado and Canada ensures that both can further develop their areas of specialization and supply each other with high-quality agricultural products. U.S.-Canada trade plays a major role in supporting jobs and prosperity for U.S. workers, businesses and families.
