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# Introduction

The Government of Canada is taking concrete action by way of continued investment to improve education facilities. To this end, Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC) supports a range of activities, including: construction of new education facilities; renovation, repair, operations and maintenance of existing facilities; and design and planning of new projects.

This Education Facilities Progress Report encompasses the period of April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2006 to March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2012. It is the third in a series of public reports outlining educational facilities projects and investments since 2006. The previous version of this report covering the period of April 2006 to December 2010 is available on AANDC's website.

Between April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2006, and March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2012, the government invested approximately \$720 million for 429 education facilities projects, including additions, renovations and minor upgrades of existing education facilities. In addition to the projects completed since 2006, 81 school projects are in various stages of completion across the country. These projects are being funded through AANDC's Capital Facilities and Maintenance Program (CFMP) and represent approximately \$244 million in total project funding.

Economic Action Plan 2012 builds on these investments by providing \$175 million over three years in new targeted funds for education facilities, starting with \$25 million in 2012-2013.

# Context

#### **Planning process**

AANDC works with First Nations through the CFMP to provide financial and advisory assistance to First Nations in the development of their basic public infrastructure, including education facilities. The CFMP objectives are to assist First Nations in making capital and facility operation and maintenance plans and investment decisions, in order to:

- Maximize the life-cycle of physical assets;
- Mitigate health and safety risks;
- · Ensure assets meet applicable codes and standards; and
- Ensure programs are managed and delivered in a cost-effective and sustainable manner.

AANDC regularly reviews its spending on education facilities to ensure that priority is given to projects that address immediate health and safety concerns.

As a condition of funding, each First Nation community is required on an annual basis to develop and submit their First Nation Infrastructure Investment Plan (FNIIP) to AANDC's regional offices. The FNIIP details the First Nation's infrastructure intentions over the next five fiscal years and acts as a vehicle to advise AANDC regions of any proposed capital projects that the community may require, including education facilities projects. First Nations involvement in the investment planning process is done directly at the community level through ongoing discussions between AANDC, First Nations and Tribal Councils.

Proposed projects are then assessed by regional officials against the National Priority Ranking Framework, which incorporates the following four priorities:

- Protection of Health and Safety of Assets: assets require maintenance, upgrading or replacement to meet appropriate standards and mitigate significant risks to health and safety;
- Health and Safety Improvements: upgrading existing assets, new construction/ acquisition projects to mitigate and identify significant risk to health and safety;
- Recapitalization/ Major Maintenance: extending the useful operating life of a facility or asset, or maintaining the original service level of the asset; and
- Growth: anticipating community growth requires new construction, expansion and procurement of education facilities to maintain the level of service standards.

Success Story Natashquan - Quebec



A contribution of \$6.4 million from Canada's Economic Action Plan (CEAP) enabled the community of Natashquan to complete the addition and renovation of Uauitshitun School on schedule and within cost. Opened in 2011, the school provides a healthy and safe learning environment for 214 First Nation kindergarten to Grade 11 students.

Starting in fiscal year 2011-2012, education facilities projects, both new construction and renovations/additions, have been further prioritized using the AANDC's School Priority Ranking Framework (SPRF). The SPRF is an internal ranking tool that was developed in response to the evolving needs of on-reserve schools. It applies a point-ranking system based on nationally-established criteria, using the following five categories:

Health and Safety requirements;

- Overcrowding (school gross area);
- Geography (remoteness, travel time and driving conditions);
- Design (grade distribution and amenities offered); and
- Partnerships (external funding sources and aggregation).

Regional FNIIPs assess all major capital school projects against the SPRF. A point ranking system is applied to each proposed project, and the results are then used to guide the Department's investment decisions in education facilities.

#### Life Cycle Management of Funded Education Facilities

AANDC promotes the use of full life-cycle costing analysis when approving capital construction projects, including education facilities. This type of analysis allows for the consideration of all associated costs (e.g. design, construction, major renovations, operations and maintenance) of the proposed infrastructure throughout its entire life cycle. This information is used to make comparisons between proposed options (e.g. building an expensive education facility with low operating and maintenance costs

versus a less-expensive education facility with higher operating and maintenance costs) and to identify the most cost-effective option in the short, medium, and long term. This exercise is also useful in determining the funding levels required by the First Nation in future years for the operations and maintenance of the proposed education facility.

The Department provides funding support to First Nations to pay for operations and maintenance during the service life of education facilities.

Moreover, AANDC tracks the ongoing condition of education facilities through inspections that are carried out at least once every three years with the Asset Condition Reporting System (ACRS). Through the ACRS inspections, a list of deficiencies is developed and provided to the First Nations and AANDC. AANDC regional officials then work with First Nations through the annual FNIIP planning process to address any identified repairs and maintenance work needed to preserve education facilities.

# Success Story Birch Narrows - Saskatchewan



Narrows in Saskatchewan is proud of their new school. In fact, it was the first education facility completed under the CEAP initiative in 2010. The Federal Government invested \$20.3 million. This project also had a cost share component with both the First Nation and the province of Saskatchewan, and took less than 14 months to complete. Partnerships, team work and First Nation planning and preparation were key to the success of this new education facility project.

# Funding and Investments


#### **Funding for Education Facilities: Overview 2006-2012**

AANDC recognizes the importance of safe and productive learning environments for First Nation students and continues to make major investments in education facilities.

Annual total investment in education facilities was \$195 million in 2006-2007, \$244 million in 2007-2008, \$208 in 2008-2009, \$277 million in 2009-2010, \$304 million in 2010-2011 and \$201 million in 2011-2012. For fiscal year 2012-2013, AANDC plans to invest approximately \$221 million on education facilities infrastructure projects and the Operation and Maintenance (O&M) of existing education facilities on reserve. (Refer to Graph 1)

The O&M component of the annual total investment in existing education facilities was \$70 million in 2006-2007, \$78 million in 2007-2008, \$76 million in 2008-2009, \$77 million in 2009-2010, \$79 million in 2010-2011 and \$82 million in 2011-2012. For fiscal year 2012-2013, AANDC plans to invest approximately \$106 million in the support of the operation and maintenance of existing education facilities on reserve. (Refer to Graph 1)

As shown in Graph 1, the spikes in capital funding in 2009-2010 and 2010-2011 are a result of targeted investments from CEAP in Budget 2009 and Budget 2010, and the Building Canada plan/ Gas Tax Fund (BCP/GTF) extension. Graph 1 shows a noticeable reduction of funding levels in 2011-2012 with the expiration of CEAP. However, Economic Action Plan 2012 committed \$175 million over three years in new targeted funds for education facilities, starting with \$25 million in 2012-2013.

#### **Targeted Funding for Education Facilities**

In recent years, AANDC has been able to undertake the funding of major education facilities projects largely through targeted funding initiatives. The Department's A-Base is mainly used to support the ongoing operations and maintenance of existing education facilities and smaller scale renovations and replacements; only minimal funding remains for large education facilities projects.

Targeted investments from CEAP in Budget 2009 and Budget 2010, and the Building Canada plan/ Gas Tax Fund (BC/GTF) extension provided \$275 million to support improved education facilities for 19 First Nation communities.

#### **Canada's Economic Action Plan**

In Budget 2009, CEAP provided approximately \$173 million over two years for the construction of nine new education facilities and the renovation of an additional three. These projects include:

Economic Action Plan 2012 builds on these investments by providing \$175 million over three years in new targeted funds for education facilities, starting with \$25 million in 2012-2013.

#### **Building Canada plan/Gas Tax Fund**

As part of the Building Canada plan, a further \$102 million was invested from the Gas Tax Fund over two years to support the construction of five new schools and two major school renovations between 2009-2010 and 2011-2012. Although funding for Kehwein First Nation in Alberta was announced, their school project was cancelled because construction could not be completed by the end of the program. This education facility project will be completed using funds from AANDC's regular capital program on a schedule that can accommodate community preferences and construction delays. As of March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2012, as outlined in chart below, four projects were substantially completed and three were in the construction stage.

# **Education Facilities projects**


#### **Completed Education Facilities Projects**

Between April 1, 2006 and March 31, 2012, there have been 429 projects completed (Annex A), which account for approximately \$720 million in expenditures. This includes the construction of 36 new schools (\$458 million), the construction and/or

renovation of at least 55 teachers' residences in 34 communities (\$11.4 million), 30 major school additions and/or renovations (\$154 million), and 329 other projects, including minor repairs, renovations and/or additions, mould and moisture remediation, mechanical system upgrades, purchase and installation of portable classrooms, feasibility studies, and design work (approximately \$96 million). 


#### **Ongoing Education Facilities Projects**

As of April 1, 2012, there are 81 education facilities projects currently underway across the country, which account for approximately \$244 million in expenditures, (Annex B). Of these, 77 projects are receiving funding through AANDC's CFMP (approximately \$186 million). This includes the initial planning, design and construction for 11 new schools (approximately \$116 million), 9 major school renovation and/or addition projects (approximately \$48 million), and 57 other minor school projects. These minor projects include additions, renovations and/or repairs of 21 schools (approximately \$7 million), the repair or replacement of 11 school roofs (approximately \$4 million), the construction and/or renovation of portable classrooms in 5 communities (approximately \$3 million), 8 feasibility studies, 9 mechanical and heating system upgrades and/or repairs, and 3 other minor projects (approximately \$9 million).

There are three remaining BCP/GTF school projects currently in the construction stage (approximately \$57.5 million), and they are all anticipated to be completed over the next two years. Two of these three projects have allocated and expended all of their designated BCP/GTF funding and are now being funded using AANDC regular capital A-Base.

Targeted funds from AADNC's First Nation Infrastructure Fund (FNIF) are supporting a green energy project for one First Nation Community, in order to promote sustainable schools facilities on reserve. The total FNIF contribution is approximately \$441,000. (Refer to Graph 4)


#### **Changes since Last Progress Report (December 2010)**

Since the last Education Facilities Progress Report April 2006 – December 2010 (available at <a href="http://www.aadnc-aandc.gc.ca/eng/1317514443289/1317514965481">http://www.aadnc-aandc.gc.ca/eng/1317514443289/1317514965481</a>) an additional 196 projects have been added to Annex A, the list of completed projects (Refer to Graph 5):

 68 projects listed as underway in the previous progress report are now completed. These projects have an approximate value of \$260 million. Several of these projects were new education facilities and additions funded under CEAP and BCP/GTF. 128 new projects were not captured in the previous progress report. These
128 projects not only include projects that were started and completed in the
2010-2012 period, but also include some smaller projects that were completed
as far back as 2006-2007. These 128 projects have an approximate value of
\$60 million.

In addition to the 196 completed projects since the previous Education Facilities Progress Report April 2006 – December 2010, 65 of the 81 school projects currently underway are new (Annex B). These 65 new education facilities projects have an estimated value of approximately \$152 million.

Given the cumulative nature of the Education Facilities Progress Report, slight variations may be noted in terms of project status and estimated projects costs.

#### **Looking Forward**

Beginning in fiscal-year 2012-2013, AANDC's ongoing funding for education facilities is being increased by \$175 million over three years through the Economic Action Plan

2012. The phased plan for the Economic Action Plan 2012 investments in First Nation education facilities includes:

- Three top priority education facilities in 2012: Fort Severn and Pikangikum First Nations in Ontario and Shamattwa First Nation in Manitoba; and
- Construction or renovation of another five high priority, shovel-ready projects to be completed by 2015, including ?aq'amnik Education Centre at St. Mary's Band in British Columbia, as well as upcoming projects at Lax Kw'alaams, Kwakiut and Tl'etinqox-t'in First Nations in British Columbia, and Peter Ballantyne First Nation in Saskatchewan;

Furthermore, AANDC will use a portion of the money allocated through Budget 2012 to examine alternative project delivery methods (e.g. design/build, modular designs, and provincial models). AANDC is working on reforming the way education facilities projects are constructed by examining various financing and construction models. Through Economic Action Plan 2012, AANDC is committing to constructing and renovating education facilities and ensuring value for money and cost savings wherever possible; ensuring that standard instructions are provided to architects; setting clear parameters on permitted design modifications and upgrading the design standards; capping project costs; setting minimum asset life expectancy at 40 years; and ensuring the use of competitive tendering.

#### Conclusion

This Education Facilities Progress Report has provided an overview of the substantial investments in educational facilities and range of projects funded by AANDC between April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2006 and March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2012. The \$920 million investments detailed in this report underline AANDC's commitment to creating and maintaining quality learning environments for First Nation students on reserve. Quality learning environments have been shown to facilitate and improve educational outcomes, and provide greater opportunities and increase participation of all First Nations in the economy.
