Articles for the use of the Governor General

GUIDELINES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The goods that are classified under and entitled to the benefits of tariff item 9809.00.00 are limited to those that have been imported for the exclusive use by the person occupying the office of the Governor General of Canada.

2. The import documentation must clearly indicate that the importer of record or the end user is the incumbent Governor General.

3. All other persons or organizations are excluded from importing goods under tariff item 9809.00.00. Among those excluded are the following:

(a) family members and relatives of the Governor General;

(b) former Governors General;

(c) the Governor General's staff;

(d) goods addressed to the Chancellery and Government House (Rideau Hall, Ottawa or the Citadel of Quebec), which are for general applications and not for the exclusive use of the Governor General; and

(e) federal government departments and agencies.
