## INTRODUCTION

Since 1945 the Fisheries Research Board of Canada, Biological Station, Nanaimo, has maintained port observers at Vancouver, Prince Rupert and, occasionally, at Victoria. They conduct interviews with trawler skippers to obtain statistics of catch and fishing effort. In 1966, 89% (by weight) of the total trawl landings was covered by the interviews. The remaining 11% was recorded from Department of Fisheries sales-slips on which no effort (hours fished) was given. Catch per unit of effort statistics obtained from the interview data were used to estimate effort expended for the catch recorded on sales-slips.

From total catch and total estimated effort data, an annual average catch per unit of effort in pounds per hour was calculated for each major fishing area. Percentage of total catch and total effort in each of these areas was also calculated. These last two statistics not only serve to show relative importance of each area but are also used in the calculation of "Success Ratio". This parameter is defined as the per cent of total catch divided by the per cent of total effort.

Total landings in 1966 of trawl-caught groundfish (excluding crab and dumped fish) by the British Columbia trawl fleet were 54,550,568 lb, 24% higher than the previous record catch in 1965. Effort expended was 28,124 hr which resulted in an overall catch per unit of effort of 1940 lb per hr, an increase of 28% over 1965.

Over 50 different species of groundfish were caught and landed by the trawl fleet (see list following).

Pacific cod continued to be the strongest contributor to the trawl fishery with landings of 26.8 million lb which were 10% greater than last year. There were marked increases in landings of rock sole which at 7.2 million lb were 135% greater than in 1965 and in landings of Pacific ocean perch (5.2 million lb) which were 70% greater than in 1965.

Area 4B - Total catch of 3.1 million lb was down 13% from the already low production of 1965 which suggests a continuing decline of interest in this area by the British Columbia trawlers. Major species caught in this area were English sole, Pacific cod and turbot (for animal food).

Area 3C - Although effort expended in this area remained about the same as in 1965, catch of 6.8 million lb was one million lb higher because of increased landings of Pacific cod. Pacific cod and lingcod were the major species landed from this area.

Area 3D - Total catch of all species was 2.4 million lb, one-half million lb higher than in 1965. However, effort associated with this catch decreased from the level observed in the previous year. Pacific cod and lingcod were major contributors to landings from this area.

Area 5A - Overall production increased to 4.6 million lb, just over one million lb higher than in 1965. This was due mainly to increased landings of Pacific ocean perch, the major species taken. Pacific cod, lingcod and rock sole also contributed greatly to the catch.

Area 5B - Landings of Pacific ocean perch at 3.5 million lb constituted over 60% of the total catch of 5.7 million lb taken from this area. Landings of this species increased 72% over those in 1965.

Area 5C - Total catch from this area at 13.0 million lb was 53% greater than in 1965. Increased landings of rock sole and Pacific cod, the main species, accounted for the bulk of the larger catch. Catch per unit of effort in Area 5C, as in 1965, was the highest recorded on the coast (3500 lb/hr).

Area 5D - This area continues to be the most important in terms of catch and effort. Total catch of 18.8 million lb was almost 35% of the total British Columbia trawl catch and total effort at 7500 hr was 27% of the total effort. Although Pacific cod was still the major species caught (10.4 million lb), rock sole landings were 3-1/2 times higher than in 1965 and amounted to 3.4 million lb.

Areas 5E and 6 - Only two or three trips were made to these areas in 1966 and from these less than 1000 lb of sablefish and only 1500 lb of Pacific ocean perch were landed.

Catch statistics have been summarized in following tables by month by major and minor statistical area, the boundaries of which are described below. Effort statistics have been summarized by month by major statistical area. The tables\* presented have been divided into three sections:

1. Tables of annual catch which include
  - a) total catch and total effort statistics for major statistical areas
  - b) total catch by main species by major statistical areas
  - c) breakdown of landings of "other flatfish" and "miscellaneous species" by major statistical areas
  - d) breakdown of landings of "animal food" by species by major statistical areas
  - e) total catch by all species by minor statistical areas

2. Tables of monthly catch by major area
  - a) breakdown of landings of "animal food" by species by month by major statistical area
  - b) landings of all species by month by major statistical area
3. Tables of monthly catch by minor area
  - a) breakdown of landings of "animal food" by species by month by minor statistical area
  - b) landings of all species by month by minor statistical area

#### AREA DIVISIONS

In 1957 informal discussions were started between Canada and the United States with a view to standardizing the reporting of groundfish catches on the Pacific coast. Prior to this, each state or province had reported catches from areas which differed in name, number, and geographical extent. As a result of these discussions the Pacific coast was divided into a series of areas, and, by unofficial consent, groundfish catches since 1957 have been assigned to them. In the United States these areas were used by the Pacific Marine Fisheries Commission in their annual summaries of catch statistics and they became known as PMFC (major) areas.

#### Major statistical area divisions

Figure 1 illustrates the major statistical areas off British Columbia and gives their numerical designation. The following is a complete description of the boundaries of these areas.

Area 3B. Upper Washington Coast. From Latitude 47°20'N to a line bearing 220° True from the mid-point of the Bonilla-Tatoosh line and crossing said latitude. This area includes the Quillayute and Umatilla Reef grounds and the shallow waters off Cape Flattery.

Area 3C. Lower West Coast Vancouver Island. From the northern boundary of Area 3B to a line bearing 200° True from Estevan Point southward to the 49° parallel of latitude, thence westward along said parallel. This area includes the Cape Flattery Spit, the Swiftsure Bank, LaPerouse Bank (Big Bank or 40-Mile Bank), the Cabbage Patch, the Firing Range, the Lennard Island and Sydney Inlet grounds, and the inshore waters of Barkley Sound.

Area 3D. Upper West Coast Vancouver Island. From the northern boundary of Area 3C to Latitude 50°30'N. This area includes the Nootka, Esperanza and Kyuquot grounds as well as the Estevan Deep.

Area 4A. The United States territorial waters inside the Bonilla-Tatoosh line including Puget Sound. No Canadian catch from this area.

Area 4B. The Canadian waters from the Bonilla-Tatoosh line inside to a line drawn north and south (Mag.) through Pine Island at the upper end of Queen Charlotte Strait. This area, defined simply as the Strait of Georgia, includes all Canadian inshore grounds of Juan de Fuca Strait, Johnstone and Queen Charlotte Straits and Georgia Strait.

Area 5A. Lower Queen Charlotte Sound. From the northern boundaries of Areas 4B and 3D to Latitude 51°15'N. This area includes all grounds incorporated in the Cape Scott Bank. It also includes catches from the Virgin Rocks ground.

Area 5B. Upper Queen Charlotte Sound. From Latitude 51°15'N to Latitude 52°00'N on the westward side of Cape St. James and from Latitude 51°15'N to Latitude 52°10'N on the eastward side of Cape St. James. This area includes all grounds associated with the Goose Island Bank.

Area 5C. Lower Hecate Strait. From Latitude 52°10'N to a line drawn from Spit Point (Sandspit) on Moresby Island to the southern tip of Bonilla Island. This area includes the grounds known as the "Horseshoe" and the "Ole Spot" in the central region of the Strait.

Area 5D. Upper Hecate Strait. From the northern boundary of Area 5C to Latitude 54°40'N, limited to the westward by Longitude 133°W across Dixon Entrance. This area includes the Two Peaks ground (northeast of Rose Spit), the Butterworth-Warrior edge, the Fingers (southwest of Archibald Island), the Oval Hill ground, the White Rock ground (northwest of Bonilla Island), the Skidegate Inlet ground, the Fife Point grounds, the grounds lying 25 miles southwest of Seal Rocks, and grounds in Dixon Entrance.

Area 5E. West Coast Queen Charlotte Islands. From Latitude 52°00'N to 54°40'N, limited to the eastward by Longitude 133°W across Dixon Entrance.

Area 6. Alaska. All the area north of Latitude 54°40'N.

#### Minor statistical area divisions

Minor areas are used to give more detailed information on region of capture of groundfish. They are areas within major areas and are basically the Department of Fisheries statistical areas with some modifications. Figure 2 illustrates the areas and the modifications are catalogued below.

- 1) The boundary between Areas 2A East and 4 has been shifted northwestward to Rose Spit. This brings the whole of the "Two Peaks" ground within Area 4.

2) The boundary between 2A East and 2B East has been shifted northward to lie along the Sandspit-Bonilla Island line. This is the internationally agreed line of division between upper and lower Hecate Strait (Major Areas 5D and 5C).

3) Minor Area 5 has been divided into two sub-areas, designated 5U and 5L, by the Sandspit-Bonilla Island line to preserve the division mentioned above.

4) The southern boundary of Areas 2BE and 6 has been shifted to lie along 52°10'N Latitude to conform with the boundary between major Areas 5C and 5B.

5) Area 8 has been expanded to include the whole of the Goose Island Bank. This has involved (a) shifting the northern boundary and eliminating Area 7, (b) shifting the southern boundary and eliminating the offshore portion of Area 9, and (c) the elimination of Area 30, previously used for offshore catches in Queen Charlotte Sound. There is, in this report, no westward limit to Area 8.

6) Area 9 has been changed and is now a circle 6 miles in diameter surrounding the Sea Otter Group and the Virgin Rock Grounds. It is considered to be part of Major Area 5A.

7) Area 11 has been expanded to include all of the Cape Scott Bank. This has meant the elimination of Area 10, the inclusion of the portion of Area 12 lying westward of Bates Passage, and the addition of the part of Area 27 lying northward of 50°30'N Latitude. This is to conform with the boundary between Major Areas 5A and 3D.

8) As a result of the modification of Area 11, Area 12 is now restricted to the inshore waters of Queen Charlotte Strait, with Bates Passage as its western limit.

9) The boundary between Areas 24 and 25 has been shifted to lie along the boundary between Major Areas 3D and 3C.

10) The boundary between Areas 23 and 24 has been shifted northwards to Portland Point and it lies on a bearing of 225° True. This is to bring the whole of the ground known as the Firing Range (which formerly lay on the boundary between these two areas) entirely within Area 23.

All other minor areas remain the same as those defined by the Department of Fisheries charts.

The following shows the relationship between the major (PMFC) and the minor areas.





