How to do the Capital Circuit:

Select your team. Each person can have their own map, but you should answer the clues together.

The Capital Circuit begins and ends at the Terry Fox statue on Wellington Street (at Metcalfe Street).

Follow the mapped route on the other side of this sheet.

Hint: You can do the Capital Circuit in either direction.

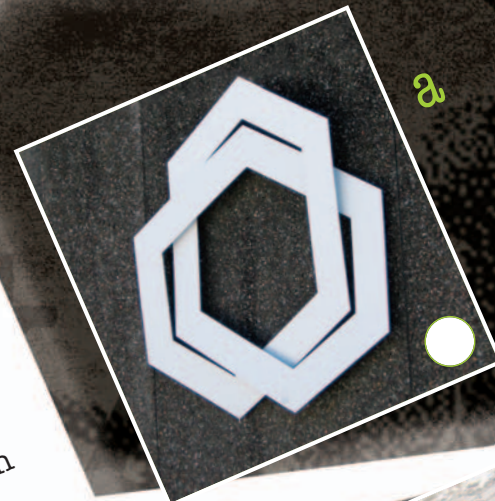
Along the way, determine the location of the six clues. Answer the question about the clue. Write your answers in the spaces provided.

Each clue is worth one point. Did you get it right?

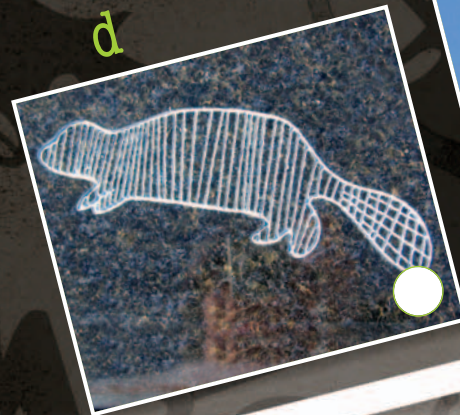
Try not to give away the locations once you have found them. Other scavenger hunters might be right behind you!
