

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1962.

INTRODUCTION:

Some estimated figures are used for the Department of National Defence, in view of the fact that October 1962 data is only partially available. For more information, see footnotes on pages 18, 23, and 30.

Employees of the Government of Canada, including its Corporations and Agencies, numbered 340,626 in October 1962 a decrease of 3,195 or 0.9 p.c. from the previous month, and 4,008 or 1.2 p.c. from October 1961. Earnings of employees in this group for the month of October 1962 totalled \$130,850,000, an increase of \$3,240,000 over September 1962, and \$3,515,000 over October 1961.

Staff strength for the month under review was lower in three of the five types of federal organizations with Proprietary Corporations accounting for the greatest decline.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES:

Employees in Agency and Proprietary Corporations and Other Agencies totalled 139,892 at the end of October 1962, representing a decrease of 2,272, or 1.6 p.c. from September 1962, and 609, or 0.4 p.c. from October 1961. Employee earnings in October 1962 amounted to \$58,751,000, an increase of \$2,476,000 over the previous month, and \$2,367,000 over October 1961.

Most of the organizations had fewer employees in October 1962 as compared with the previous month but over half of the decline is attributable to the Canadian National Railways. Significant employment decline also occurred in Trans-Canada Air Lines and Canadian Arsenals Limited. The increase in earnings is accounted for almost exclusively by the Canadian National Railways with a \$3,000,000 larger payroll, including wage increases and retroactive payments.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

In an effort to avoid a more extended delay in the release of this report, estimated figures have been included for salaried staff of Defence Research and Development, and, prevailing rate, ships' officers and crews, and casual staff in the entire Department of National Defence.

Preliminary figures for October 1962 indicate a staff strength of 200,734, a decrease of 923, or 0.5 p.c. from September 1962, and 3,399 or 1.7 p.c. from October 1961. Employment was lower in October 1962 than in the previous month for: salaried, down by 440, prevailing rate, down by 780; ships' officers and crews down by 66. Casual and others, however, were higher by 363. Employee earnings for October 1962 amounted to \$72,099,000, up by \$764,000 or 1.1 p.c. from September 1962, and up by \$1,148,000 or 1.6 p.c. from October 1961.

The principal variations in October 1962 in staff strength, when compared with previous months are: an indicated decline in salaried and casual employment in the function "Defence Services"; an increase in salaried employees in the function "Protection of Persons and Property - Corrections"; an increase in casual employees in the function - "Social Welfare - National Employment and Unemployment Insurance Services" due to seasonal increase of the Unemployment Insurance Commission; a decrease of prevailing rate employees in the function "Recreational and Cultural Services - Parks, Beaches and other Recreational Areas", mainly due to seasonal decline of Northern Affairs and National Resources; an increase in casual employees in the function "Education - Indian and Eskimo schools and schools in N.W.T." due to the hiring of caretakers for the school year by Citizenship and Immigration; a decrease of prevailing rate and an increase of casual employees in the function - "Natural Resources and Primary Industries - Lands: Settlement and Agriculture" due to Agriculture's seasonal decline of prevailing rate and the hiring of extra casual help for the harvesting season.


