

## NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1962.

INTRODUCTION:

In view of the fact that November 1962 data are only partially available, some estimated figures are used for the Department of National Defence. For more information see footnotes on pages 18, 23 and 26.

Employees of the Government of Canada, including its corporations and agencies, numbered 334,436 for the month of November 1962, a decrease of 6,190 or 1.8 p.c. from the previous month, and 7,948 or 2.3 p.c. from November 1961.

Earnings of these employees for November 1962 amounted to \$126,374,000, a decrease of \$4,-476,000 from October 1962, but an increase of \$1,120,000 over November of the previous year.

Staff strength for November 1962 was lower in three of the five types of federal organizations, with "Other Agencies" and "Departmental Corporations" showing a slight increase.

## FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

November 1962

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES:

Employees in Agency and Proprietary Corporations and Other Agencies totalled 135,054 at the end of November 1962, representing a decrease of 4,838 or 3.5 p.c. from October 1962, with each province showing a decrease, and 3,555 or 2.6 p.c. from November 1961.

Earnings of employees in this group amounted to \$55,069,000 in November 1962, a decrease of \$3,682,000 from the previous month, but an increase of \$726,000 over November 1961.

The decline in employment and earnings is accounted for mainly by the seasonal decline within the Canadian National Railways. The Northern Transportation Company Limited and the Canadian Arsenals Limited also reported a significant decrease in employment.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

In an effort to avoid a more extended delay in the release of this report, estimated figures have been included for salaried staff of Defence Research and Development, and, prevailing rate, ships' officers and crews and casual staff in the entire Department of National Defence.

November 1962 preliminary figures indicate a staff strength of 199,382, down 1,352 or 0.7 p.c. from October 1962, and 4,393 or 2.2 p.c. from November 1961. Employee earnings for November 1962 amounted to \$71,305,000, down \$794,000 or 1.1 p.c. from October 1962, and up \$394,000 or 0.6 p.c. from November of the previous year.

The principal variations in staff strength for the month of November 1962, when compared with the previous month are: an indicated decline in salaried and casual employment in the function "Defence Services"; a substantial increase of casual employees in the function "Social Welfare - National Employment and Unemployment Insurance Services" due to a seasonal increase of the Unemployment Insurance Commission; a decrease of prevailing rate employees in the function "Recreational and Cultural Services - Park, Beaches and other Recreational Areas"; a decline of prevailing rate and casual employees in the function "Natural Resources and Primary Industries - Lands: Settlement and Agriculture" due to seasonal decline of the Department of Agriculture; and an increase of casual employees in the function "Other - Post Office" due to seasonal increase of the Post Office Department.


