FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

DECEMBER 1962

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1962.

INTRODUCTION:

Some estimated figures are used for the Department of National Defence in view of the fact that December 1962 data are only partially available. For more information, see footnotes on pages 18, 23 and 26.

Employees of the Government of Canada including its corporations and agencies, indicate a staff strength of 330,306 at the end of December 1962. This represents a decrease of 4,130 or 1.2 p.c. from the November 1962 figure, and 6,592 or 2.0 p.c. from December 1961.

Total earnings for the month of December amounted to \$126,494,000, an increase of \$120,000 over the previous month and \$2,299,000 over December 1961.

Total earnings for the calendar year 1962 amounted to \$1,544,157,000 an increase of \$36,823,000 or 2.4 p.c. over the previous calendar year.

Staff strength for the month under review was lower than in November 1962 in four of the five types of federal organizations, with Proprietary Corporations accounting for the greatest decline.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER WHENCIES:

Employees in Agency and Proprietary Corporations and Other Agencies totalled 132,035 at the end of December 1962, a decrease of 3,019 or 2.2 p.c. from November 1962, and 2,735 or 2.0 p.c. from December 1961. Earnings of employees in this group amounted to \$55,071,000 an increase of \$2,000 from November 1962 and \$1,643,000 from December 1961. There is an indicated increase in the calendar year 1962 over the 1961 calendar year of 2.0 p.c.

The seasonal employment decline over November 1962 is mostly attributable to the Canadian National Railways, although the National Harbours Board, Trans-Canada Air Lines and Canadian Arsenals Limited also indicate a decrease. Employee earnings are practically unchanged from the previous month, involving decreases mainly in the Canadian National Railways but offset by retroactive payments by other organizations.

FART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

In an effort to avoid a more extended delay in the release of this report, estimated figures have been included for salaried staff of Defence Research and Development, and, prevailing rate, ships' officers and crews, and casual staff in the entire Department of National Defence.

Employees in Departmental Branches, Services and Corporation's totalled 198,271 at the end of December 1962, which represents a decrease of 1,111 or 0.6 p.c. from the previous month, and 3,857 or 1.9 p.c. from December 1961. Total earnings of these employees amounted to \$71,423,000 in December 1962, an increase of \$118,000 from November 1962 and \$656,000 from December 1961.

During the last five months of 1962, a net decline of 12,839 employees occurred. This 6.1 p.c. reduction in staff from 211,110 at July 31, 1962 to 198,271 at December 31, 1962 resulted mainly from two factors:

- 1. Economy measures introduced by the Government of Canada, effective July 13, 1962 are estimated to have resulted in a decline of between 4,000 and 4,100 employees by December 31, 1961.
- 2. Seasonal declines, customary during the latter part of the year, accounted for most of the remaining 8,700 reduction in staff.

It is thus estimated that economy measures accounted for a staff reduction of approximately 2 p.c. and seasonal declines for approximately 4.0 p.c. during the five month period. For comparative purposes employment declined by 7,842 employees or 3.7 p.c. from 209,970 at July 31, 1961 to 202,128 at December 31, 1961.
