

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1962.

INTRODUCTION:

The quarterly table on hirings and separations of salaried employees for the second quarter of 1962 is included in this report.

Some estimated figures are used for the Department of National Defence because July 1962 data are only partially available. For more information, see footnotes on pages 18, 23 and 30.

The Government of Canada, including its corporations and agencies, had 356,580 employees at the end of July 1962. This represents an increase of 1.1 p.c. or 3,973 from June 1962 but was only slightly above the July 1961 count.

Total employee earnings for July 1962 amounted to \$134,643,000, up 2.3 p.c. or \$2,976,000 from June 1962 and 2.4 p.c. or \$3,142,000 from July 1961.

Staff strength was higher in July 1962 when compared with the previous month in four of the five types of federal organizations. The most significant change occurred in Proprietary Corporations, up by 3,136 from 130,141 in June 1962.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES:

Employees in Agency and Proprietary Corporations and Other Agencies totalled 145,511 at the end of July 1962, an increase of 2.3 p.c. or 3,219 from June 1962 but a decrease of 0.5 p.c. or 742 from July 1961. Total employee earnings for the month of July 1962 amounted to \$60,446,000, up 4.9 p.c. or \$2,842,000 from June 1962 and 1.2 p.c. or \$741,000 from July 1961. The bulk of the increase in employees and their earnings in July 1962 over the preceding month is accounted for by the Canadian National Railways.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

In order to avoid a more extended delay in the release of this report, estimated figures have been included for salaried staff of Defence Research and Development, and, prevailing rate, ships' officers and crews and casual staff in the entire department of National Defence.

Preliminary figures for July 1962 indicate a total staff strength of 211,069, up 0.4 p.c. or 754 from June 1962, and 0.5 p.c. or 1,099 from July 1961. Employment was higher than in June for three of the four types of employees. The group having the greatest gain were salaried employees, up by 718. Total employee earnings for July 1962 were \$74,196,000 up slightly (by \$133,000) from June 1962 and 3.3 p.c. or \$2,400,000 above July 1961.

The principal variations in July staff strength when compared with that for June 1962 are: an indicated rise of prevailing rate staff in the function "Defence Services"; fewer casuals in "Transportation and Communications - Airways" because of reductions in the Air Services Branch of Transport; more casuals in "Transportation and Communications - Waterways" due to increased activity by the Harbours and Rivers Engineering Branch of Public Works; a drop in casuals for "Social Welfare" caused by a decline in unemployment which enabled the Unemployment Insurance Commission to reduce its staff; the function "Natural Resources and Primary Industries" recorded increased prevailing rate employment in "Lands, Settlement and Agriculture" because of activities of the Research Branch, Department of Agriculture.

Analysis of the quarterly table on hirings and separations of salaried employees for the second quarter of 1962 indicates: (1) a high separation rate for Legislation accounted for by the dissolution of Parliament in April 1962 and; (2) large hiring rates for both Fisheries and Forestry departments, mainly due to seasonal employment during the period.


