

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1962.

INTRODUCTION

Some estimated figures are used for the Department of National Defence because August 1962 data are only partially available. For more information, see footnotes on pages 18, 23 and 26.

The Government of Canada, including its corporations and agencies, had 351,013 employees at the end of August 1962. This represents a decrease of 1.6 p.c. or 5,567 from July 1962 and of 1.4 p.c. or 5,059 from August 1961.

Total employee earnings for the month of August 1962 amounted to \$133,594,000, down by \$1,049,000 from July 1962 and up by \$2,618,000 from August 1961.

Staff strength was lower in August 1962 when compared with the previous month in four of the five types of federal organizations. The most significant decline occured in Departmental Branches and Services.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES:

Employees in Agency and Proprietary Corporations and Other Agencies totalled 144,574 at the end of August 1962 which represents a decrease of 0.6 p.c. or 937 from July 1962 and of 0.9 p.c. or 1,340 from August 1961. Earnings of these employees in August 1962 amounted to \$60,255,000, down by \$191,000 from July 1962 and up by \$1,602,000 from August 1961. About half of the decline in employment in August 1962 from the preceding month is accounted for by the Canadian National Railways.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

In order to avoid a more extended delay in the release of this report, estimated figures have been included for salaried staff of Defence Research and Development, and, prevailing rate, ships' officers and crews, and casual staff in the entire department of National Defence.

Preliminary figures for August 1962 indicate a total staff strength of 206,439, down 2.2 p.c. or 4,630 from July 1962 and 1.8 p.c. or 3,719 from August 1961. Employment was lower than in July for three of the four types of employees, particularly casuals which declined by 2,269. Total employee earnings for August 1962 were \$73,340,000, down 1.2 p.c. or \$856,000 from July 1962 but up 1.4 p.c. or \$1,017,000 from August 1961.

The principal variations in August 1962 staff strength, when compared with the preceding month, are: an indicated substantial decline in salaried, prevailing rate and casual employees in the function "Defence Services"; decrease in salaried, prevailing rate and casual employees in the function "General Government - Executive and Administrative" involving several branches of departments; a decline of casual staff in the function "Transportation and Communications - Waterways" possibly due to reduced activities by the Harbours and Rivers Engineering Branch of Public Works and the Marine Services Branch of Transport; reduced salaried and casual employees in the function "Social Welfare - National Employment and Unemployment Insurance Services" due to seasonal decline of the Unemployment Insurance Commission, and; a decline of casual staff in the function "Education - Indian and Eskimo Schools and Schools in N.W.T." due to completion of repairs or improvements to schools.
