

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1962.

INTRODUCTION

Some estimated figures are used for the Department of National Defence, in view of the fact that September 1962 data are only partially available. For more information, see footnotes on pages 18, 23 and 26.

Employees of the Government of Canada, including its corporations and agencies, numbered 343,811 at the end of September 1962. This represents a decrease of 7,202 or 2.1 p.c. from the August 1962 figure, and 5,358 or 1.5 p.c. from September of the previous year.

Total employee earnings for the month of September 1962 amounted to \$127,610,000, a decrease of \$5,984,000 from the preceding month, and an increase of \$286,000 from September 1961.

Staff strength for the month under review was lower than in August 1962 in four of the five types of federal organizations, with Departmental Branches and Services accounting for the greatest decline.

While the Government's announced policy of reducing overall expenditures has, no doubt, had some effect on the size of the staff decrease a precise measurement cannot be made because of other contributing factors such as the return of students to school and the release of seasonal staff.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES

Employees in Agency and Proprietary Corporations and Other Agencies totalled 142,164 at the end of September 1962, representing a decrease of 2,410, or 1.7 p.c. from August 1962, and 1,404 or 1.0 p.c. from September 1961. Earnings of this group in September amounted to \$56,275,000, a decrease of \$3,980,000 from the previous month, but an increase of \$144,000 over September 1961.

More than half of the September 1962 decline in employment in this group over August 1962 is accounted for by the seasonal decline within the Canadian National Railways.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS

In an effort to avoid a more extended delay in the release of this report, estimated figures have been included for salaried staff of Defence Research and Development, and, prevailing rate, ships' officers and crews, and casual staff in the entire Department of National Defence.

Preliminary figures for September 1962 indicate a staff strength of 201,657, down by 4,782, or 2.4 p.c. from August 1962, and 3,944, or 2.0 p.c. from September 1961. Employment was lower than in August for all four types of employees, with prevailing rate employees decreasing by 1,816 or 7.1 p.c. and casuals decreasing 1,525 or 12.5 p.c. Employee earnings for September amounted to \$71,335,000, a decrease of \$2,005,000, or 2.7 p.c. from August 1962, and a slight increase of \$142,000 over September of the previous year.

The principal variations in September staff strength, when compared with the preceding month, are: an indicated substantial decline in salaried, prevailing rate and casual employment in the function "Defence Services"; a decrease in salaried and casual employees in the function "General Government - Executive and Administrative", which involves several branches of departments, but an increase in "Legislative" salaried staff, due to the opening of the 25th Parliament on the 27th of September; a decrease in prevailing rate and casual employment in the function "Transportation and Communications", principally in the field of airways, highways, roads and bridges, and waterways; a further decrease from last month in the function "Social Welfare - National Employment and Unemployment Insurance Services" due to a seasonal decline of the Unemployment Insurance Commission; a decline in the salaried and prevailing rate employees in the function "Natural Resources and Primary Industries" principally "Fish and Game; Forests and Lands; Settlement and Agriculture". In the function "Education", there was an increase in salaried staff in "Indian and Eskimo Schools and Schools in the N.W.T", presumably due to resumption of school activities.


