NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1962.

INTRODUCTION:

Some estimated figures have been used for the department of National Defence, in view of the fact that January 1963 data are only partially available. For more information, see footnotes on pages 18, 23 and 30.

Employees of the Government of Canada, including its corporations and agencies, indicate a staff strength of 329,654 at the end of January 1963. This represents a decrease of 652 or 0.2 p.c. from December 1962 and 7,874 or 2.3 p.c. from January of the previous year.

Total earnings for the month of January 1963 amounted to \$144,572,000, an increase of \$18,078,000 or 14.3 p.c. over December 1962, and \$18,844,000 or 15.0 p.c. over January 1962, mainly due to payment of retroactive salary increases.

Staff strength for the month being reviewed reflected slightly higher employment in three of the five types of federal organizations, with Proprietary Corporations showing the greatest increase.

FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

January 1963

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES:

Employees in Agency and Proprietary Corporations and Other Agencies totalled 131,083 in January 1963, a decrease of 952 or 0.7 p.c. from December 1962; and 1,268 or 1.0 p.c. from January 1962. Earnings of these employees in January 1963 amounted to \$55,371,000, an increase of \$300,000 over December 1962 and \$1,784,000 over January 1962.

The decline in employment from December 1962 was mostly due to the Canadian National Railways, and secondly to the National Harbours Board, but offset to some extent by the Polymer Corporation reporting overseas employees for the first time.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

In an effort to avoid a more extended delay in the release of this report, estimated figures have been included for salaried staff of Defence Research and Development, and, prevailing rate, ships' officers and crews and casual staff in the entire Department of National Defence.

Salary revisions were announced for a group of salaried employees, the majority of which were effective October 1961. It is estimated that the retroactive payments to December 1962 amounted to some \$15,800,000. Regular earnings for January 1963 include the revised salaries for that month.

Beginning with this report, data for the Canadian Government Travel Bureau is included with the Department of Trade and Commerce. The official date of the transfer to that Department from the Department of Northern Affairs and National Resources was November 27, 1962.

January 1963 preliminary figures indicate a staff strength of 198,571, up 300 or 0.2 p.c. from December 1962 but down 6,606 or 3.2 p.c. from January 1962. Employee earnings for January 1963 amounted to \$89,201,000, up \$17,778,000 or 24.9 p.c. from December 1962 and \$17,060,000 or 23.6 p.c. from January 1962.

The principal variations in staff strength for the month of January 1963, when compared with the previous month are: an indicated decrease in salaried employees and increase in casual employees in the function "Defence Services"; a decline of casual employment in the function "Transportation and Communications - Waterways", due mainly to reduced seasonal activities in the Harbours and Rivers Services of Public Works; and, an increase of prevailing rate and casual employees in the function "Recreational and Cultural Services - Parks, Beaches and other Recreational Areas" due to increased seasonal operations in the National Parks Branch of Northern Affairs and National Resources.
