## FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

NOVEMBER 1963

## NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1963.

INTRODUCTION:

Employees of the Government of Canada, including its corporations and agencies totalled 336,673 at the end of November 1963. This represents a decrease of 1,657 or 0.5 p.c. from October 1963 but an increase of 2,270 or 0.7 p.c. from November 1962.

The total payroll for November 1963 amounted to \$133,362,000, a decrease of \$3,781,000 from October 1963 but an increase of \$6,737,000 from November 1962.

The decline in staff strength over October 1963 has occurred mainly in the proprietary corporations and departments.

Remarks: The salaries and wages is an important component of total Federal Government expenditures. Its relationship with total expenditures is demonstrated in Table 15 of the report "Financial Statistics of the Government of Canada, 1961 - Revenue and Expenditure - Direct and Indirect Debt-Actual", catalogue 68-211 which was released recently.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES:

Employees in Agency and Proprietary Corporations and Other Agencies totalled 134,608 at the end of November 1963, representing a decrease of 1,383 or 1.0 p.c. from October 1963 and of 446 or 0.3 p.c. from November 1962.

Earnings of employees in this group amounted to \$56,859,000 in November 1963, a decrease of \$2,810,000 from October 1963 but an increase of \$1,581,000 from November 1962.

The decline in employment and earnings is accounted for mainly by the seasonal decline within the Canadian National Railways. The Northern Transportation Company Limited also reported a significant decrease in employment.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

Employees in Departmental Branches, Services and Corporations totalled 202,065 at the end of November 1963, a decrease of 274 or 0.1 p.c. from October 1963, but an increase of 2,716 or 1.4 p.c. from November 1962.

Total earnings of these employees amounted to \$76,504,000 for November 1963, a decrease of \$970,000 from October 1963 but an increase of \$5,157,000 from November 1962.

The principal variations in staff strength by function, for the month of November 1963 when compared with the previous month, are outlined in the following table:
