FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

FEBRUARY 1963

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1962.

INTRODUCTION:

Some estimated figures are used for the Department of National Defence in view of the fact that February 1963 data are only partially available. For more information, see footnote on pages 18, 23 and 26.

Employees of the Government of Canada, including its corporation and agencies, indicate a staff strength of 327,790 at the end of February 1963, representing a decrease of 1,864 or 0.6 p.c. from January 1963 and 9,992 or 3.0 p.c. from February of the previous year. The decrease from January 1963 is accounted for mostly by staff reduction in the Canadian National Railways.

Total earnings of these employees for the month of February 1963 amounted to \$125,351,000, a decrease of \$19,221,000 from the preceding month, but an increase of \$2,085,000 over February 1962. The substantial decline over January 1963 results mainly from the inclusion in the latter month of some \$16,000,000 in retroactive payments for Departmental Branches, Services and Corporations.

Staff strength for the month under review was lower than in January 1963 in all of the five types of federal organizations with Proprietary Corporations accounting for 73 p.c. of the decline.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES:

Employees in Agency and Proprietary Corporations and Other Agencies totalled 129,635 in February 1963, a decrease of 1,448 or 1.1 p.c. from January 1963 and 2,580 or 2.0 p.c. from February 1962.

Earnings of these employees amounted to \$52,310,000 in February 1963, a decrease of \$3,061,000 from January 1963 but an increase of \$645,000 from February 1962.

The decline in the number of employees and their earnings in February 1963 from the previous month is due mostly to the staff reduction of the Canadian National Railways. The Trans-Canada Air Lines also indicate a decrease in employees and earnings.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

In an effort to avoid a more extended delay in the release of this report, estimated figures have been included for salaried staff of Defence Research and Development, and, prevailing rate, ships' officers and crews, and casual staff in the entire Department of National Defence.

Preliminary figures for February 1963, indicate a staff strength of 198,155, a decrease of 416 or 0.2 p.c. from January 1963 and 7,412 or 3.6 p.c. from February of the previous year.

Total earnings of these employees amounted to \$73,041,000 in February 1963, a decrease of \$16,160,000 or 18.1 p.c. from January 1963, but an increase of \$1,440,000 or 2.0 p.c. from February 1962. The substantial decline in February 1963 from the previous month is accounted for by the inclusion of some \$16,000,000 in retroactive payments in January 1963.

The principal variations in staff strength for the month of February 1963 when compared with the previous month are: an indicated increase of casual employment in the function "Defence Services"; a substantial decline of salaried employees in the function "General Government - Legislative" due to the dissolution of Parliament on the 6th of February; a decline of casual staff in the function "Social Welfare - National Employment and Unemployment Insurance Services" due to seasonal decline of the Unemployment Insurance Commission, and; an increase of casual employees in the function "Natural Resources and Primary Industries - Other".


