FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

MARCH 1963

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1962.

INTRODUCTION:

Arrangements have now been made with the Department of National Defence for improved timeliness and coverage, adding approximately 700 employees to data previously reported. The February 1963 data in this report have been revised on the new basis. Included in this report for the first time are: the National Centennial Administration, and prevailing rate employees of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police.

Employees of the Government of Canada, including its corporations and agencies, indicate a staff strength of 328,640 at the end of March 1963, representing an increase of 132 from February 1963 and a decrease of 9,535 or 2.8 p.c. from March 1962. Total earnings of these employees for March 1963 amounted to \$126,273,000, an increase of \$719,000 or 0.6 p.c. from February 1963 and a decrease of \$1,901,000 or 1.5 p.c. from March 1962.

The total earnings of Federal Government employees for the fiscal year ended March 1963 amounted to \$1,568,052,000, up \$44,559,000 or 2.9 p.c. from \$1,523,493,000 for the fiscal year ended March 1962.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATION AND OTHER AGENCIES:

Beginning with this month, employment data of the National Centennial Administration is included.

The Agency and Proprietary Corporations and Other Agencies had a total of 129,819 employees at the end of March 1963. This indicates an increase of 184 or 0.1 p.c. from February 1963 and a decrease of 2,803 or 2.1 p.c. from March 1962. Earnings of these employees amounted to \$53,770,000 in March 1963, an increase of \$1,293,000 or 2.5 p.c. from February 1963 and a decrease of \$278,000 or 0.5 p.c. from March 1962. The increase in earnings from February 1963 is accounted for mainly by the Canadian National Railways, which reported a payroll \$950,000 higher.

Total payroll for the fiscal year ended March 1963 amounted to \$677,977,000, up \$10,769,000 or 1.6 p.c. from \$667,208,000 for the fiscal year ended March 1962.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

Arrangements have now been made with the Department of National Defence for improved time-
liness and coverage. This improved coverage has resulted in the addition of approximately 700 employees
to data previously reported. The revised figures for February 1963 shown in this report were prepared
on the new basis.

Beginning with this month, statistics on prevailing rate employees are included for the Royal
Canadian Mounted Police. There were 67 such employees at the end of the month.

Statistics for March 1963 indicate a staff strength of 198,821, a decrease of 52 from February
1963 and 6,732 or 3.3 p.c. from March 1962. Total earnings of these employees amounted to \$72,503,000
in March 1963, a decrease of \$574,000 or 0.8 p.c. from February 1963 and \$1,624,000 or 2.2 p.c. from
March 1962.

The principal variations in staff strength for the month of March 1963 when compared with the
previous month are: a decrease of salaried employees in the function "Defence Services"; an increase
of salaried employees in the function "General Government-Executive and Administrative", mainly due to
added staff in the Taxation Division, Department of National Revenue; a decline of casual employees in
the function "Social Welfare - National Employment and Unemployment Insurance Services", which results
from diminishing seasonal workload of the Unemployment Insurance Commission; an increase of prevailing
rate and casual employees in the function "Recreational and Cultural Services - Parks, Beaches and
other Recreational Areas"; and a decrease of casual employees in the function "Natural Resources and
Primary Industries-Other".

Total employee earnings for the fiscal year ended March 1963 amounted to \$890,075,000, up
\$33,790,000 or 3.9 p.c. from \$856,285,000 for the fiscal year ended March 1962. Earnings of salaried
employees increased by \$37,027,000 to \$750,733,000.
