#### FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

JUNE 1963

#### NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1963.

## INTRODUCTION:

Employees of the Government of Canada, including its corporations and agencies, totalled 344,801 at the end of June 1963, an increase of 6,267 or 1.9 p.c. over May 1963 but a decrease of 8,122 or 2.3 p.c. from June a year earlier. The Canadian National Railways and the Department of National Defence accounted for about two thirds of the increase over May 1963.

Total earnings of these employees for June 1963 amounted to \$131,478,000, a decrease of \$1,-659,000 from May 1963 and of \$415,000 from June 1962. The decrease from May 1963 resulted mainly from fewer working days in June 1963 as compared with the previous month.

Fotal employee earnings for the first six months of 1963 amounted to \$791,082,000, an increase of \$24,872,000 or 3.2 p.c. over the same 1962 period, largely accounted for by the inclusion of retroactive salary increases for a number of classes of employees in Departments and Departmental corporations.

#### PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES:

The Agency and Proprietary Corporations and Other Agencies had a total of 138,463 employees at the end of June 1963 as compared with 135,155 in May 1963 and 142,292 in June of the previous year. This indicates an increase in June 1963 over May 1963 of 3,308 or 2.4 p.c., but a decrease of 3,829 or 2.7 p.c. from June 1962. The increase over May 1963 is accounted for mainly by the Canadian National Railways.

Earnings of these employees amounted to \$56,861,000 in June 1963, a decrease of \$1,137,000 or 2.0 p.c. from the previous month, and of \$972,000 or 1.7 p.c. from June a year earlier. The decrease in earnings from May 1963 is largely attributable to fewer working days in June 1963 as compared with the previous month.

Total employee earnings for the first six months of 1963 amounted to \$332,206,000, an increase of \$3,289,000 or 1.0 p.c. over the same six month period a year earlier.

## PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

Employees in Departmental Branches, Services and Corporations at the end of June 1963 totalled 206,338, an increase of 2,959 or 1.5 p.c. over May 1963, but a decrease of 4,293 or 2.0 p.c. from June 1962. Total earnings of these employees amounted to \$74,616,000 for June 1963, a decrease of \$523,000 from the previous month but an increase of \$556,000 over June 1962. The decrease in total earnings from May 1963 is accounted for mainly by fewer working days in June 1963 as compared with May 1963 and smaller overtime payments during that month.

The principal variations in staff strength, by function, for the month of June 1963 when compared with May 1963, are outlined in the following table:

Total employee earnings for the first six months of 1963 amounted to \$458,877,000, up \$21,585,-000 from the corresponding period of 1962 mainly due to the inclusion of retroactive salary increases for a number of classes of employees.
