



FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

SEPTEMBER 1963

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1963.

INTRODUCTION:

Employees of the Government of Canada, including its corporations and agencies, totalled 342,588 at the end of September 1963, a decrease of 5,922 or 1.7 p.c. from August 1963, and of 1,122 or 0.3 p.c. from September 1962.

Total earnings of these employees for the months being reviewed amounted to \$134,577,000, \$137,740,000 and \$127,906,000, respectively.

The decrease in staff strength is reflected in four out of the five types of federal organizations, with departmental branches and services accounting for the greatest decline, principally due to the release of seasonal staff.

FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES:

The Agency and Proprietary Corporations and Other Agencies had a staff strength of 139,550 at the end of September 1963, a decrease of 2,371 or 1.7 p.c. from the previous month, and of 2,614 or 1.8 p.c. from September of the preceding year. The decrease in employees is largely attributable to the Canadian National Railways.

Earnings of these employees amounted to \$58,276,000 in September 1963, a decrease of \$1,805,000 from the previous month and of \$221,000 from September 1962.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

Employees in Departmental Branches, Services and Corporations at the end of September 1963 totalled 203,038, a decrease of 3,551 or 1.7 p.c. from August 1963, but an increase of 1,492 or 0.7 p.c. over September a year earlier. The September 1963 decrease in staff strength is principally due to the release of seasonal employees.

Total earnings of these employees for the months being reviewed aggregated \$76,300,000, \$77,659,000 and \$71,409,000.
