FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

NOVEMBER 1964

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other background detail, in the report for April, 1964.

INTRODUCTION:

Canada's federal government had 340,882 employees in all services (excluding the Armed Forces) at the end of November 1964. This total was 1,534 fewer than in October 1964 with three of the five main groups (excepting departmental corporations and other agencies) recording a decrease. The November 1964 total was up 1.3 p.c. or 4,209 from the 336,673 employed in the same month a year ago.

Total staff earnings for November 1964 amounted to \$142.6 million, down 0.7 p.c. from October 1964, but up by 6.9 p.c. or \$9.2 million from November 1963.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES:

Employment in this group numbered 136,336 at the end of November 1964, a decline of 1.4 p.c. or 1,945 from the previous month but a rise of 1.3 p.c. or 1,728 from November 1963.

The Canadian National Railways reported some 1,400 fewer employees. The railway reduced staff in all provinces but Saskatchewan. Payroll decreased by \$1.8 million from the previous month but was up \$1.8 million from November 1963.

During October and November 1964 there was the usual substantial decrease in staff of the Northern Transportation Company. This is due to completion of their summer program.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

Employees in this group totalled 204,546 at the end of November 1964. This represents a slight increase of 411 from October 1964 and was up 1.2 p.c. or 2,481 from November 1963. Total employee earnings for the month under review amounted to \$80.0 million, down 0.8 p.c. from October 1964, but 4.5 p.c. or \$3.5 million higher than November 1963.

Analysis of the November data by function indicates an increase in the function "Health and Social Welfare - Other Social Welfare" which is the beginning of a winter works program by Citizenship and Immigration, Indian Affairs Branch. The function "Public Service and Trading Enterprises" increased due to engaging of additional help to handle a particularly heavy shipment of grain.
