## NOTE TO ANALYSTS

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1963.

# INTRODUCTION:

Employees of the Government of Canada, including its corporations and agencies totalled 332,-431 at the end of February 1964. This represents a decrease of 336 from January 1964 and an increase of 3,916 or 1.2 per cent from February of last year.

Total employee earnings for the month of February 1964 amounted to \$132,113,000, a decrease of \$2,890,000 or 2.1 per cent from January 1964 and an increase of \$6,551,000 or 5.2 per cent from February of last year.

# PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES:

Employees in Agency and Proprietary Corporations and Other Agencies totalled 130,755 at the end of February 1964, representing a decrease of 219 from January 1964 and an increase of 1,120 or 0.9 per cent from February 1963.

Total earnings of these employees amounted to \$55,064,000 in February 1964, down \$2,154,000 or 3.8 per cent from January 1964 and up \$2,587,000 or 4.9 per cent from February 1963.

## PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

Employees in Departmental Branches, Services and Corporations totalled 201,676 at the end of February 1964 as compared to 201,793 in January 1964 and 198,880 in February 1963.

Total earnings of this group amounted to \$77,048,000 at the end of February 1964, a decrease of \$736,000 or 0.9 per cent from January 1964 and an increase of \$3,964,000 or 5.4 per cent from February 1963.
