FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

MAY 1964

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1964.

INTRODUCTION:

Total civilian employment of the Government of Canada, including its corporations and agencies, was 341,153 on May 31, 1964. This represented an increase of 5,601, or 1.7 p.c. over April and an increase of 2,619, or 0.8 p.c. over May 1963.

Staff earnings for the month amounted to \$137,931,000; almost unchanged from April but \$4,794,-000, or 3.6 p.c. over May a year ago. These employees earned \$679,506,000 in the first five months of 1964 compared with \$659,605,000 for the same period in 1963.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES:

Beginning with this issue, statistical data on employees of the Office of the Representation Commissioner are included.

Staff strength increased to 135,686 at the end of May 1964, from 132,670 in April, while comparable figures for May of the preceding year were 135,155.

Employees in this group earned \$59,808,000 in May 1964, an increase of \$1,623,000, or 2.8 p.c. over April and \$1,810,000 or 3.1 p.c. over May 1963. Canadian National Railways, which has most of the employees in this group, accounted for nearly all of the increase.

For the second consecutive month the Northern Transportation Company reported substantial increases in both employees and earnings, due to increased spring activities.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

In this group staff strength was 205,467 at the end of May 1964, an increase of 2,585 or 1.3 p.c. over April, and 2,088, or 1.0 p.c. over May a year ago.

They earned \$78,123,000 in May, down 1.8 p.c. from April, but 4.0 p.c. higher than May 1963.

The only group showing significantly higher earnings for May than April is "Casuals and Others", where an increase of \$288,000, or 8.4 p.c. is shown. This is due to the fact that, in the past, university students who held positions identified as "Student Assistants", "Technical Officers", etc., were counted as "Salaried" employees. However, beginning this year, these employees have been paid on an hourly rate basis and are, therefore, included under "Casuals and Others".
