FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

JUNE 1964

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1964.

INTRODUCTION:

Civilian employees of the Government of Canada, including its corporations and agencies, totalled 347,841 at the end of June 1964. This evidences a month to month growth of 2.0 p.c. or 6,688; however, staff expansion over June 1963 was only 0.9 p.c. or 3,040 employees.

Total employee earnings for June amounted to \$142,818,000, which was 3.5 p.c. or \$4,887,000 over May and 8.6 p.c. or \$11,340,000 more than June earnings of the previous year.

Cumulative earnings for the period January to June amounted to \$822,325,000, compared to \$791,-082,000 a year ago.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES:

Staff strength in this group increased from 135,686 at the end of May, to 140,226 at the end of June 1964. The comparable figure for June 1963 is 138,463.

Total monthly earnings of these employees were \$63,427,000, a rise of 6.1 p.c. or \$3,619,000 over the previous month, and 11.5 p.c. or \$6,566,000 greater than a year ago.

Canadian National Railways, which has the most employees in this group, accounted for most of this earnings increase.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

Staff in this group totalled 207,615 at the end of June, representing an increase of 2,148 employees over the previous month, and 1,277 over June 1963.

Earnings of this group increased slightly over May but were 6.4 p.c. or \$4,775,000 greater than those of the previous year.

The principal variations in staff strength at the end of June 1964, when compared to May, are outlined in the following table:


