FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

AUGUST 1964

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1964.

INTRODUCTION:

Civilian employees of the Government of Canada, including its corporations and agencies, numbered 353,592 at the end of August 1964. This is 677 below July, but 1.5 p.c. or 5,082 over August 1963.

Earnings for the month were \$143,865,000, 1 p.c. below the previous month but 4.4 p.c. or \$6,125,000 over August 1963.

Accumulated earnings for the period January - August were \$1,111,600,000 as opposed to \$1,-081,914,000 for the comparable period in 1963. This was an increase of \$29,686,000. A total of \$707,791,000 was earned since April 1, 1964, as compared to \$684,561,000 during the same term in 1963.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES:

In this group, staff strength increased to 144,232 at the end of August, from 143,717 in July and 141,921 in August 1963.

Although staff strength increased from July to August, the monthly earnings decreased. August earnings dropped 1.5 p.c. or \$955,000 to \$63,675,000 compared to July, but increased by 6.0 p.c. or \$3,594,000 over August 1963.

Of the thirty enterprises forming this group, eight reported higher payrolls for August than for July, three reported negligible changes from July, while the remainder showed varying decreases.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

These activities were staffed by 209,360 employees at the end of August, a reduction of 1,192 from the previous month, but an increase of 2,771 over August 1963. The greatest staff decline occurred among "Casuals and Others" with a smaller drop in the number of prevailing rate employees.

Regular earnings of these 209,360 federal employees amounted to \$80,190,000 for the month, which was slightly less than in July, but was 3.3 p.c. or \$2,531,000 above August 1963.
