FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

NOVEMBER 1965

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other background detail, in the report for April, 1965.

Introduction:

November 1965 civilian employment and payroll of federal departments and corporations registered only small changes from October 1965. Total employment at 346.1 thousand in November 1965 was 1,400 (0.4 p.c.) less than October but was up 6,400 (1.9 p.c.) from November 1964. Total payroll (\$155.8 million) increased 1.2 p.c. over October 1965 (\$154.0 million) and 9.6 p.c. over November 1964, (\$142.2 million).

Cumulative payroll, January 1 to November 30, 1965 was \$1.66 billion, up 6.8 p.c. from the \$1.55 billion payroll in the comparable period of 1964. April 1 to November 30, payrolls aggregated \$1.23 billion compared to \$1.15 billion during the same period in the 1964-65 fiscal year.

FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

November 1965

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES:

Employment in these organizations dropped 1.1 p.c., from 139.1 thousand in October 1965 to 137.5 thousand in November. These decreases were mainly seasonal layoffs and occurred in all provinces. There were 136.3 thousand employees in November 1964.

Total monthly payroll increased 1.9 p.c. from October (\$66.6 million) to November (\$67.8 million) 1965. The November 1964 payroll was \$62.6 million. The 1.9 p.c. payroll increase reflected a substantial increase (+ 31.9 p.c.) in Air Canada payroll due to a difference of one pay-period between the two months.

Cumulative payroll for January 1 to November 30, 1965 was \$717.4 million, compared to \$674.0 for the same period of 1964. Payroll for the eight months, April 1 to November 30, of the 1965-66 fiscal year amounted to \$533.5 million, \$29.7 million above the 1964-65 period.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

Employees of this group numbered 208.6 thousand at the end of November 1965, a slight increase over October and 2.6 p.c. above the previous November strength of 203.4 thousand. An October-November comparison shows employee decreases in all groups but 'salaried'. Total payroll for the month at \$87.9 million, was slightly above October (0.7 p.c.) and 10.5 p.c. more than the November 1964 payroll of \$79.6 million.

Cumulative payroll for the January 1 to November 30, 1965 period was \$941.4 million, 7.0 p.c. or \$61.6 million more than for the like period of 1964. For the first 8 months of the 1965-66 fiscal year (April 1 to November 30, 1965) payroll aggregated \$700.5 million, compared to \$646.1 for the same 8 months of 1964-65.

A comparison, by function, with the previous month indicates a considerable decrease (16.4 p.c.) in the number employed under "Highways, Roads and Bridges" due to layoffs resulting from adverse winter weather conditions along the Northwest Highway System. This resulted in the release of both prevailing rate and casual employees. Under "Aid to Unemployed Employables" there was an increase of over 400 employees, both salaried and casual, reflecting the increase in requests for Unemployment Insurance Benefits under the 1965-66 Seasonal Benefit Period which commenced November 28. (For detail on the operation of the Unemployment Insurance Act, see the DBS publication Catalogue No. 73-001). "Parks, Beaches and Other Recreational Areas" were closed at the end of the season causing a 12.2 p.c. drop among salaried and casual employees.
