## FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

MARCH 1965

## NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other background detail, in the report for April, 1964.

INTRODUCTION:

Although the number of Federal Government civilian employees rose only 0.2% (568) from February 1965, the total employee earnings were 3.2% (\$4.4 million) higher. Staff of proprietary corporations received 2.3% (\$3.3 million) more pay, (see page 6).

The organizations forming Part A accounted for less than half (39.7% at March 31, 1965) of the total staff covered in this publication but received almost two-thirds of the staff increase since March 1964. Staff of the Part B organizations (61.3% of the total staff) received about one-third of the increase. They also accounted for two-thirds of the 5.2% rise in payrolls over March 1964 whereas the Departmental staffs received about one-third of the increased pay.

Cumulative earnings for the first three months of 1965 rose 5.2% over the same three months of 1964 and the 1964-65 fiscal year payrolls increased 5.6% from those of 1963-64.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES:

Employment in these organizations was virtually stationary during March, as was the case in February. However, the payrolls jumped 6.2%; the Canadian National Railways with a payroll increase of \$2.7 million was, as usual, the major influencing factor. This occurred mainly because there were more working days in March than in February.

There were increases in both numbers (2.2%) and earnings (8.7%, mainly CNR) over March 1964. Fiscal year payrolls increased 7.6% (\$52.9 million) from 1963-64 to 1964-65.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

The total number of these employees was virtually unchanged from February 1965 (+0.4%) and March 1964 (+0.8%); casuals showed the only increase in March 1965 (1,020 or 7.4%). Regular earnings were up 2.4% from February and 6.1% from March 1964. Monies earned in March 1965 included \$236,000 paid as regular earnings to ships' employees in lieu of holidays as compensatory leave credits.

Departmental staffs increased by 5.1% during March 1965; whereas, departmental corporations had a staff decrease of 1.7%. Both of these changes resulted from variations in casuals; departments had decreases and departmental corporations no change in salaried, prevailing rate and ships' employees.

Cumulative earnings for the 1964-65 fiscal year were \$970.2 million, an increase of \$37.8 million, or 4.1% from the 1963-64 figure of \$932.4 million.
