### FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

### JUNE 1965

### NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other gackground detail, in the report for April, 1965.

# INTRODUCTION:

Federal government departments, corporations and agencies employed a civilian staff of almost 350,000 at the end of June 1965. This was an increase of 1.3% over May 1965 and 0.8% over June 1964. Payroll of these organizations for June 1965 was \$148 million, down slightly from May 1965 but up 4.1% from June 1964.

Payroll for the period January to June 1965 aggregated \$868 million, compared to \$822 million a year ago (5.6% difference). Cumulative payrolls for April to June were \$443 million in the 1965 period and \$418 million (6.0% difference) in the 1964 period.

# PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES:

Staff of this group totalled 141,000 at the end of June 1965, an increase of 2,000 (1.6%) over May 1965 and less than one per cent above June last year.

Regular payrolls were \$65.6 million, \$1.2 million or 1.8% below May 1965 but \$2.2 million or 3.4% above June 1964. Major decreases in the payrolls, due to a decrease in the number of pay periods from three to two, of Air Canada and St. Lawrence Seaway Authority were offset by an increase in the Canadian National Railway's payroll and minor increases elsewhere.

Payrolls for the first six months of 1965 amounted to \$379 million compared to \$352 million for the same period a year ago.

## PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

These organizations were staffed by 209,000 people in June 1965, up 1.1% from May 1965 and up 1.0% from June 1964. Regular payrolls of \$82.9 million for June 1965 are 0.9% greater than the May 1965 payrolls of \$82.1 million and 4.8% more than the June 1964 payrolls of \$79.1 million. There were no significant changes in either numbers or payrolls in the month-to-month comparisons.

Cumulative payrolls for the first six months of 1965 were \$489 million, a rise of 3.9% over the same period of 1964. Payrolls aggregated \$248 million in the April - June 1965 period, 4.8% over the comparable payrolls of 1964.


