## NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other background detail, in the report for April, 1966.

## INTRODUCTION

Civilian staff of the Federal Public Service dropped to 363.7 thousand at the end of December 1966 from 365.9 thousand in November, while the total payroli increased to $\$ 184.9 \mathrm{million}$, $\$ 7.6 \mathrm{millin}$ above the November payroll. For comment regarding this increase see Part B, page 7 . A comparison with December 1965 indicates employment and payroll increases of 19.0 thousand and $\$ 30.0 \mathrm{million}$, respectively.

Cumulative payroll for the 1966 calendar year amounted to $\$ 2,048$ mililon, $\$ 233.9$ million more than the 1965 payroll. Approximately 5 per cent of this annual increase of $\$ 234$ million is attributable to a gradual growth of the government structure, while the balance is due to salary revisions within the year.

For the nine months of the $1966-67$ fiscal year, aggregate payrolls amounted to $\$ 1,570 \mathrm{mill}$, 110 n , \$181.2 million above the same nine months of 1965-66.

## PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES

Total December 1966 employment ( 142.4 thousand) and payrolls ( $\$ 75.4$ million) of this group changed slightly from November. The month-tomonth comparison indicates a staff decrease of 0.5 per cent from 143.1 thousand, but a payroll increase of 1.1 per cent from $\$ 74.6$ million. The year-to-year comparison shows an employment increase of 4.2 per cent and payrolis 13.0 per cent above December 1965.

Cumulative payroll for the 1966 calendar year amounted to $\$ 856.8$ million, 9.3 per cent above the 1965 total of $\$ 784.2$ million. For the nine months of this fiscal year, cumulative payrolls totalled $\$ 659.9$ million, 9.9 per cent higher than the same period of 1965-66.

A slight decrease occurred in the staff streng th of these organizations during the month to 221.3 thousand employees. But over the year total staff increased 6.4 per cent, from 208.1 thousand.

The regular payroll for the month increased 0.9 per cent to $\$ 100.2$ million, whereas the total payroll was up 6.6 per cent to $\$ 109.5$ million from November, and 24.2 per cent above December a year ago. This increase was due mainly to the inclusion of retroactive pay increases, covering extended periods of time and amounting to approximately $\$ 5.6$ million, to salaried employees of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police and to certain other salaried employees of the Public Service.

Payroll for the calendar year was $\$ 1,191$ million in 1966, compared to $\$ 1,030$ million for 1965. Accumulative payrolls for the nine months of the $1966-67$ fiscal year show an increase of 15.4 per cent to $\$ 910.3$ million, from $\$ 788.7$ million for the same months of 1965-66.

Practically all of the variations, noted in an analysis of employment by function, are of a seasonal nature. The departments (and branches) most affected, and all of which report staff decreases, are: Agriculture (Canadian Government Elevators): Fisheries (Fisheries Management and Development): Indian Affairs and Northern Development (National Parks), and Public Works (Harbours and Rivers Engineering Service and Roads, Bridges and Other Engineering Services).
