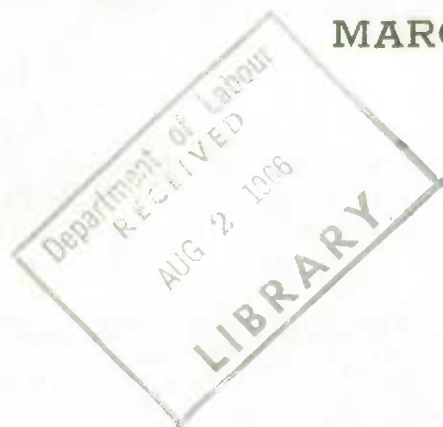

FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

MARCH 1966

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1965.

INTRODUCTION:

Total civilian employment in the Federal Public Service was 348.9 thousand at March 31, 1966. This was 2.8 thousand or 0.8 p.c., greater than February 1966 and 11.7 thousand, or 3.5 p.c., more than March 1965.

The monthly payroll of \$158.4 million was up \$4.8 million, or 3.2 p.c., from February 1966 and \$14.7 million, or 10.2 p.c., from March 1965.

The 1965-66 fiscal year payroll was \$1.87 billion, a rise of \$147 million or 8.6 p.c. over the previous fiscal year payroll. Cumulative payroll January 1 to March 31 was \$478 million in 1966 as opposed to \$425 million in 1965, a gain of 12.4 p.c.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES:

Employment in these organizations increased slightly during March to 136.2 thousand. Payroll was up 6.2 per cent to \$67.4 million compared to \$63.5 million for February. Comparable figures for March 1965 were 133.7 thousand employees, paid \$62.9 million.

Payrolls for the 1965-66 fiscal year aggregated \$797.2 million, 6.1 per cent above the 1964-65 fiscal year.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS:

These employees numbered 212.6 thousand in March 1966, up 1.2 p.c. from February and 4.5 p.c. from March 1965.

Regular payrolls at \$88.9 million were 1.6 p.c. greater than February and 11.4 p.c. more than March 1965. Like comparisons of total monthly payrolls indicated advances of 1.0 p.c. and 12.7 p.c. respectively.

The month-to-month comparison, by function, of staff strength identified increases in the Department of Northern Affairs and National Resources affecting functions:

- (a) "Education: Indian Schools, Eskimo Schools and Schools in N.W.T." - a large increase in the number of teachers due to an audit of records.
- (b) "Natural Resources and Primary Industries: Other" - increase in casual and prevailing rate employment at Yellowknife, N.W.T.

Aggregate payroll for the period January 1 to March 31 was up 16.5 p.c., from \$240.8 million in 1965 to \$280.6 million in 1966. This payroll increase occurred largely in regular payrolls (up \$28.5 million) and to a lesser extent in retroactive and overtime payments (up \$11.3 million).

A comparison of fiscal year payrolls shows an increase of 8.0 p.c. in regular payroll. In contrast total payroll was up by 10.5 p.c. due to heavy increases in retroactive and overtime payments. Further details are shown below.

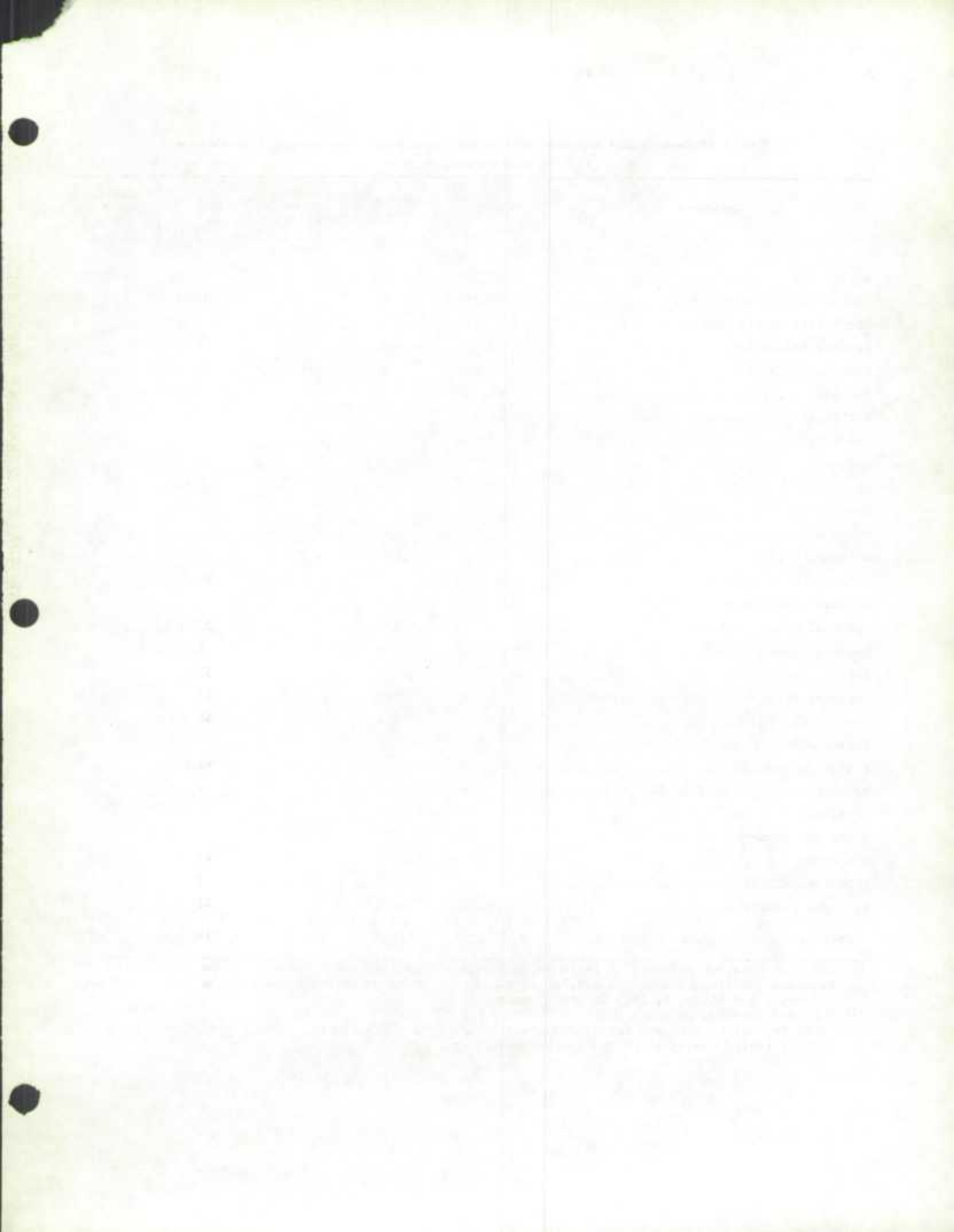
