NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1966.

INTRODUCTION

Total Federal Government employment increased from 372.9 thousand in July to 376.7 thousand at the end of August 1966. Payrolls were up 2.5 p.c. from \$172.0 million to \$176.3 million. In August 1965, there were 357.3 thousand employees earning \$153.3 million, indicating yearly increases of 5.4 p.c. and 15.0 p.c. respectively.

Cummulative payrolls for the eight months, January - August 1966, totalled \$1,328 million, 13.1 p.c. above the same eight months of 1965. For the first five months of the current fiscal year, payrolls amounted to \$850.4 million, 13.4 p.c. higher than the April-August 1965 period.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES

Employment in this group increased slightly over July to 149.5 thousand at the end of August and was 4.9 thousand (3.4 p.c.) higher than in August 1965. Payrolls for the month amounted to \$68.2 million, \$6.2 million (8.3 p.c.) below the previous month but slightly above August 1965.

The strike of Canadian National Railways clerks during August, was the main cause of the payroll decrease. Another factor was the inclusion, in the July report, of considerable amounts as retroactive pay. The effect of the decrease was somewhat lessened by:

- (a) increased seasonal employment by National Harbours Board.
- (b) a pay increase, including retroactive payments, to employees of the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation, plus
- (c) a \$150 thousand "incentive" bonus paid to employees of Northern Transportation Company.

Cumulative payrolls for the first eight months of 1966 were \$549.4 million, 6.5 p.c. above the \$515.8 million paid for the equivalent period in 1965.

Payrolls for the period April - August, amounted to \$352.5 million, 6.2 p.c. more than the same five months of 1965.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS

Staff strength in this group, at 227.2 thousand, was up 3.3 thousand (1.5 p.c.) from July and 14.5 thousand (6.8 p.c.) from August 1965. The year-to-year increase is due largely to improved administrative facilities coincident with a major reorganization of the departments of government which began in December 1965. In addition, the inclusion of Semi-staff employees of the Post Office department (formerly footnoted but not included in the main tables) caused an increase of some 6 thousand employees. The increase is most noticeable among salaried employees where 12.1 thousand of the above 14.5 thousand are shown.

Gross payroll for the month amounted to \$108.1 million, up 11.1 p.c. from July and 27.1 p.c. above August 1965. The payroll includes retroactive payments of \$8.5 million to approximately 41.7 thousand salaried employees in the Administrative Support Group (mainly clerks, typists, office equipment operators, etc.), and total overtime payments amounting to \$2.3 million.

Aggregate payroll for the eight month period totalled \$778.5 million, 18.2 p.c. more than the same period of 1965. For the first five months of the fiscal year, payrolls amounted to \$497.9 million, compared to \$417.8 million for the period April - August, 1965.

The creation of the Department of Manpower and Immigration resulted in a number of changes in function. Employees formerly shown in "Universities, Colleges and Other Schools" (line 6, page 12) are now included in "National Employment Service" (line 26, page 10). Some personnel previously recorded under "Immigration and Citizenship" (line 19, page 12) are now included in "Labour" (line 25, page 10). In addition both "National Employment Service" and "Labour" functions have been increased through the establishment of new positions. Other changes were mainly seasonal in nature. Until the major reorganization of departments has been completed and more detail is available, there will be considerable difficulty in producing meaningful comparisons on a function basis.
