## FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

## NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1966.

## INTRODUCTION

Civilian employment in the Public Service increased to 365.4 thousand ( 0.5 p.c.) at the end of January 1967, from 363.7 thousand in December 1966, at the same time payrolls decreased to $\$ 182.1$ million ( 1.5 p.c.) from $\$ 184.9$ million for December. In January 1966 employees totalled 344.7 thou sand and payrolls amounted to $\$ 165.5$ million, indicating year-to-year increases of 6.0 p.c. and 10.1 p.c. respectively.

Payrolls aggregated $\$ 1,752.3$ million from April 1, 1966 to January 31, 1967 and $\$ 1,554.4$ million for the same months of $1965-6 \pi$, representing an increase of 12.7 p.c.

The employment and payroll for the above group increased slightly during January to 143 thousand employees with a payroll of $\$ 76.4$ million. A provincial, month-to-month, comparison of the numbers of employees shows that, of the ten provinces, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and Ontarlo recorded staff increases, whereas on the payroll side, Quebec alone reported a decrease. In a comparison of January 1966 to January 1967 substantial increases are indicated: staff strength was up by 7 thousand ( 5.2 p.c.) from 136 thousand and payrolis increased $\$ 10.4$ million ( $11.7 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$.) from $\$ 66.0 \mathrm{mill}$ ion for January 1966. With few exceptions, increases were shown by all Crown corporations and agencies.

Aggregate payroll, April 1966 to January 1967 amounted to $\$ 736.3$ million, compared to $\$ 666.3$ million for the same ten-month period of the $1965-66$ fiscal year.

## PART B - DEPARTMENTS AND DEPARTMENTAL CORPORATIONS

Staff strength of these organizations was 222.4 thousand at the end of January 1967 , slightly above the December employment ( 1 thousand) and 6.6 p.c. ( 13.7 thousand) more than in January 1966. Total payroll for the month was $\$ 105.7$ million, down $3.5 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. ( $\$ 3.6$ miliion) Erom December 1966, but 6.3 p.c. higher than the previous January.

Cumulative payrolls for April 1, 1968 - January 31, 1967 were $\$ 1,016 \mathrm{million}$, a gain of 14.4 p.c. ( $\$ 127.8$ miliion) over the same ten months of the $1965-66$ fiscal year. A function analysis shows a few minor variations, all of a seasonal nature.

[^2]On October 1, 1966 the "Government Organization Act 1966" was proclaimed in force. It was reported in the summary for the third quarter that some of the changes that are authorized by the Act had already taken place.

The above Act sets up various Departments, and outlines their powers etc. as follows:
(1) Department of the Solfeitor General which shall have juriediction over:
(a) reformatories, prisons and penitentiaries,
(b) parole and remissions,
(c) the Royal Canadian Mounted Police.
(2) Department of the Registrar General shall have jurisdiction over:
(a) combines, mergers, monopolies and restraint of trade,
(b) patents, copyrights and trade marks,
(c) bankruptcy and insolvency,
(d) corporate affairs.
(3) Department of Manpower and Immigration shall have jurisdiction over:
(a) the development and utilization of Manpower resources in Canada,
(b) emp loyment services.
(c) immigration.
(4) Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development shall have jurisdiction over:
(a) Indian Affairs,
(b) the Northwest Territorles and the Yukon Tertitory and their resources and affalrs,
(c) Eskimo affairs,
(d) National parks,
(e) National battlefields, historic sites and monuments,
(f) migratory birds and other wild life.
(5) Department of Forestry and Rural Development, shall have jurisdiction over:
(a) all matcers relating to forest resources not assigned to another department, etc. of the government,
(b) matters relating to rural development that are assigned to the Minister.
18) Napartment of Energy, Mines and Resources shall have jurisdiction over:
(a) energy, mines and minerals, water and other resources,
(i) explosives,
(i) technical surveys within the meaning of the "Resources and Technical Surveys Act".
(7) The Treasury Board is set up as a Department.

As a result of the above reorganization, there were many changes of responsibility between departments, wich led to increases and decreases of the staff of those departments. In our publications dated April and october, 1966, these changes are outlined.

Some notes on changes in staff strength in departments other than those that were reorganized is given below.
Civil Service Comission. This shows a high monthiy rate of hirings during the fourth quarter. This is due to the expansion of language training facillties that is being done.

Dominion Bureau of Statigtics. - Continued to show a considerable staff turnover, resulting from the 1966 quinquennial censua.

Royal Canadian Mint. - The decrease 18 due to the fact that the Mint has caught up with the demand for Minted sets of coins.

Fisheries. - Separations were high due to the relesse of "Fishery Wardens" at the end of the season. These are experienced employees who are hired each spring for a seven to nine month period, depending on the area they work in.

Forestry and Rural Development. The build up is due to the reorganization, and increased programs.
Industry. - This department has been growing fairly steadily for some time.

Royal Commasions. - The separation rate is high due to a diminution of the activities of Royal Commissions that are

Veserins Affairs. - The marked number of soparations is due to the transfer of the Sunnebrook Hospital to the lindersi$y$ of Tandatit.
