

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1967.

INTRODUCTION

Federal Government employees, including those of corporations and agencies but excluding the armed forces, numbered 383.5 thousand on the last working day of May 1967. This represented increases of 10.0 thousand (2.7 p.c.) over April and 22.9 thousand (6.3 p.c.) over May 1966.

Gross payrolls amounted to \$190.1 million, slightly less than for April, but \$23.2 million (13.9 p.c.) above the figure for May 1966.

Cumulative payrolls for the period January 1, to May 31, 1967 were \$927.0 million, compared to \$810.7 million for the same five-month period of 1966, an increase of 14.3 p.c.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES

There were 153.3 thousand employees in this group at the end of May 1967, 4.1 p.c. above April and 8.2 p.c. greater than for May 1966. Total payroll for the month, at \$82.4 million, represented an increase of 3.4 p.c. over April, and 14.7 p.c. above the figure for May 1966.

With the opening of "Expo 67" the highest per cent increases over the previous month (April), were reported by the Canadian Corporation for the 1967 World Exhibition, with increases of 86 p.c. and 68 p.c., respectively, in employment and payrolls. Other variations were seasonal, with increased activity indicated by Construction, Industry, Recreation and Transportation.

In an April-May comparison by area, most of the provinces and territories reported increased staffs and higher payrolls. Nova Scotia recorded the greatest decrease in employment, both in numbers and payroll.

Aggregate payroll for the first five months of 1967 amounted to \$391.5 million, compared to \$335.2 million at the end of May 1966.

PART B - DEPARTMENTS AND DEPARTMENTAL CORPORATIONS

The number of employees in this Group increased by 1.8 p.c. during May 1967, to 230.2 thousand from 226.2 thousand at the end of April. During the same time total payrolls decreased 2.5 p.c. to \$107.8 million from \$110.6 million for the previous month. Comparable figures for May 1966 were 218.9 thousand employees with a total payroll of \$95.1 million.

Cumulative payrolls for the period January 1 to May 31, 1967 amounted to \$535.5 million, 12.6 p.c. greater than the same period of 1966.

All provinces and territories show staff increases, with the greatest being in British Columbia and the Yukon and Northwest Territories. A functional analysis reveals that 65 p.c. of the additional employees were students engaged as "Casual" employees for summer projects. The more noteable changes are identified in the following paragraph by department and type of service rendered.

Under the group, "Transportation and Communications-Highways, Roads and Bridges", <u>Public Works</u> reported an increase of casual employees. Under the function group "Natural Resources and Primary Industries", three departments: Energy, Mines and Resources, Fisheries, and Forestry and Rural Development recorded a total increase of approximately 2100 employees, of which 90 p.c. were Casuals, the remainder being Prevailing Rate employees. The group "Other-International Cooperation and Assistance" reported increased Salaried and Casual employees for summer projects instituted by External Aid, External Affairs.
