NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other background detail, in the report for April 1967.

INTRODUCTION

Federal Government employees, including those of corporations and agencies but excluding the armed forces, numbered 398.9 thousand at the end of July, 1967. This represented increases of 6.0 thousand (1.5 p.c.) over June and 26.0 thousand (7.0 p.c.) over July 1966.

Gross payrolls amounted to \$198.4 million, slightly higher than for June, but \$26.4 million (15.4 p.c.) above the figure for July of the previous year.

Cumulative payrolls for the period January 1 to July 31, 1967 at \$1,322 million, were 14.8 p.c. above the same seven-month period of 1966. Payrolls for the first four months of the current fiscal year totalled \$775.1 million, compared to \$674.0 million for the same four months of 1966-67.

<u>Please note</u>: The Central Personnel Records System is converting Federal employment data to a computor program. To facilitate the conversion program only three more issues of "Federal Government Employment" will be published for the remainder of the 1967-68 fiscal year. The next release will be based on conditions as at the end of September, 1967. December 1967 and March 1968 data will be issued as it becomes available.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES

There were 162.7 thousand employees in this group at the end of July 1967, 2.0 p.c. above June and 9.4 p.c. greater than for July 1966. Total payroll for the month, at \$87.1 million, represented an increase of 1.7 p.c. over June, and 17.2 p.c. above the figure for July 1966.

Employment and payroll increases were reflected in all provinces and territories, except New Brunswick, where both the number employed and the total payroll were below the June figures.

Cumulative payrolls for January 1 to July 31, 1967 amounted to \$564.3 million, up 17.3 p.c. from 1966. Payrolls for the first four months of the 1967-68 fiscal year totalled \$334.8 million, 17.8 p.c. above that for the same period of 1966-67.

PART B - DEPARTMENTS AND DEPARTMENTAL CORPORATIONS

The number of employees in this Group increased by 1.2 p.c. during July 1967 to 236.2 thousand from 233.4 thousand at the end of June. During the month total payrolls increased slightly to \$111.3 million from \$110.5 million for the previous month. Comparable figures for July 1966 were 223.8 thousand employees and a total payroll of \$97.6 million. Staff increases were reported by two-thirds of the Departments, in all regions.

Cumulative payrolls for the seven-month period, January-July 1967, amounted to \$757.3 million, 13.0 p.c. greater than the same months of 1966. Payrolls for the first four months of the 1967-68 fiscal year totalled \$440.2 million, 13.0 p.c. above the figure for the 1966-67 period.

A functional analysis of the July employment indicates the greatest concentration of new employees is again under the "Casual" category, reflecting the hiring of students for summer projects. The functional variations are seasonal and all less than 10 p.c.

Second quarter, 1967

Comments

An analysis of hirings and separations among salaried employees for the second quarter of 1967 indicates a number of variations. In most instances they are seasonal changes such as occurred in the Departments of Agriculture and Forestry where "hirings" are high, due to the re-opening of Research stations or augmenting the present staffs to handle the increased volume of work. The Departments of Energy, Mines and Resources and Transport also re-engage personnel for numerous surveys and other projects dependant on summer weather conditions. Hirings by the Post Office appear high, reflecting the transfer of a considerable number of Semi-staff Offices to full "Operational" status. In each of the three months this affected from 150 to 300 employees.

The "Separation" ratios were higher than for hirings in the Departments of Justice, National Defence, National Health and Welfare, the Public Service Commission, the Unemployment Insurance Commission, and Veterans Affairs.

A comparison of this quarterly summary with the same quarter of 1966 shows many variations, chiefly due to the Governmental Re-Organization of October 1966, or to a re-organization within a department. Changes of these types were covered in the issue for the month in which they occurred.

Notes and Definitions

This table is published four times a year, in the January, April, July and October issues of this publication.

The table shows for the three month period, by department and sex:

- (a) Average employment
- (b) Monthly average (pertaining to hirings and separations)
- (c) Monthly rate per 1,000 employees (pertaining to hirings and separations)

Owing to the fact that relatively small changes in the staff of small departments can result in erratic fluctuations in the hiring and separation rates, such rates are not shown for "departments" with less than 100 employees (indicated by*). The average hired and separated, as well as the average employment, are shown for the use of any person wishing to calculate such rates. However, aggregates for these departments are given in "Total-Departments with less than 100 employees", as well as in "Total-All Departments".

The following definitions apply to this table:

- "Hiring" means the appointment of a person to a salaried position (as defined on page 52 in the April, 1967, publication). Movements within a department are not considered as hirings.
- 2. "Separation" means the termination of service of an employee in the reporting "department" leaving the Government Service or by transferring to another "department". Movements within a "department" are not considered as separations.
- 3. "Department", for this table only, is altered to include departmental branches or services having a separately administered personnel office.
