## INTRODUCTION

Civilian staff of the Federal Public Service decreased very slightly in March to 369.4 thousand employees. Payrolls for the period January through March 1968, totalled $\$ 581.2$ million 0.52 p.c. 1ess than for October - December 1967, but $6.35 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. above the payrolls for the same three months of 1967 .

The employee decrease occurred in Part A only and will be covered in the comments relating to Table 2. Agency and Proprietary Corporations and Other Agencies.

Cumulative payrolls for the $1967-68$ fiscal year amounted to $\$ 2,340$ million, compared to $\$ 2,117$ million for 1966-67, representing a $10.5 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. increase over the year.

Employment in this Group at the end of March 1968 showed 133.9 thousand employees and a payroll of $\$ 227.8$ million for the three months, January to March. This represented decreases from the 0ctoberDecember period of 4.8 thousand employees ( $-3.5 \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{c}$.$) and \$ 19.2$ million ( $-7.8 \mathrm{p}, \mathrm{c}$ ) in payrolls. Compared to the same three months of 1967, the decreases were 10.4 thousand ( -7.2 p.c.) fewer employees and $\$ 1.6$ million ( -0.7 p.c.) drop in payrolls.

These decreases, in both staff and payrolls, were attributable to the Canadian National Railways, down approximately 2,300 employees and a payroll decrease of $\$ 12.0$ million, and to Expo 67 where the staff strength decreased by 2,600 and the payroll by $\$ 5.6$ miliion. A number of corporations, including Atomic Energy of Canada, Canadian Arsenals, Defence Construction, Air Canada and the Bank of Canada reported a greater number of employees and increased payrolls thereby lessening the overall effect.

A comparison by province shows employment decreases in all provinces except Prince Edward Island, with the greatest being in Quebec, while the payrolls were down across the country and abroad.

Cumulative payrolls for the 1967-68 fiscal year amounted to $\$ 983.3$ million, which was 10.6 p.c. above the 1966-67 figure.

[^0]The number of employees in this Group increased during March 1968 to 235.5 thousand, 4.8 thousand ( $2.09 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}_{\mathrm{C}}$ ) above the December 1967 figure of 230.7 thousand, and 4.5 p.c. above March 1967. The greatest increase was shown for "Casuals and Others", while figures for "Prevailing Rate" employees indicated fewer than in March and December 1967.

Total payrolls for the three months amounted to $\$ 353.4$ milion, compared to $\$ 337.2$ millions for October - December 1967, an increase of $4.8 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{c}$. This payroll includes retroactive payments of approximately $\$ 8.8$ million to some 100,000 public servants in the Professional and Technical groups and those in the Foreign Service and Administrative Support groups. The increase was effective July 1, 1967 for those in the Professional and Technical categories and to October 1,1967 for those in the Foreign Service and Administrative Support categories. Cumulative payrolls for the fiscal year amounted to $\$ 1,356$ million, compared to $\$ 1,227$ milion for $1966-67$.

In this issue of Federal Government Employment, the Department of Consumer and Corporate Affairs is shown for the first time. Following the passing of Bill C-161 in December 1967, the Department of Consumer and Corporate Affairs was established. This department assumed the duties, powers and functions relating to: (a) consumer affairs; (b) corporations and corporate securities; (c) combines, mergers, monopolies and restraint of trade; (d) bankruptcy and insolvency; and (e) patents, copyrights and trade marks, of which, all but (a) were previously under the jurisdiction of the Registrar General. For this issue only, the new Department is in the alphabetic position of the Registrar General. With the new fiscal year this will be corrected.

A functional analysis shows some variations, mainly of a seasonal nature.

## Notes and Definitions

This table is published four times a year, in the January, April, July and October issues of this publication.

The table shows for the three month period, by department and sex:
(a) Average employment
(b) Monthly average (pertaining to hirings and separations)
(c) Monthly rate per 1,000 employees (pertaining to hirings and separations)

Owing to the fact that relatively small changes in the staff of small departments can result in erratic fluctuations in the hiring and separation rates, such rates are not shown for "departments" with less than 100 employees (indicated by ${ }^{+}$). The average hired and separated, as well as the average employment, are shown for the use of any person wishing to calculate such rates. However, aggregates for these departments are given in "Total-Departments with less than 100 employees", as well as in "Total-A11 Departments".

The following definitions apply to this table:

1. "Hiring" means the appointment of a person to a salaried position (as defined on page 52 in the April, 1967, publication). Movements within a department are not considered as hirings.
2. "Separation" means the termination of service of an employee in the reporting "department" by leaving the Govermment Service or by transferring to another "department". Movements within a "department" are not considered as separations.
3. "Department", for this table only, is altered to include departmental branches or services having a separately administered personnel office.
