

INTRODUCTION

This publication presents information with respect to employment in and payrolls of the federal government and the federal government enterprises. It provides information for the quarter ending December 31, 1970 and also for each of the months included therein.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics being precluded from publishing data which might permit the identification of individuals, it has been necessary to combine data in respect of the executive category with those in respect of the scientific and professional category. The same restraint has necessitated the combination of data relating to employment outside Canada with those of the Yukon and Northwest Territories, and the elimination of certain detailed analysis provided in publications prior to the July - September 1970 issue.

Employment in the federal government including enterprises, but excluding members of the Canadian Forces, was 378.9 thousand as of December 31, 1970. This represented a net increase of 0.3 thousand over employment as of September 30, 1970. Total payroll for the quarter, as reported in this publication, was \$771 million and represented a net decrease of \$6.5 million from the total for the previous quarter. This total excludes, for departments and departmental corporations, overtime payments and retroactive salary payments for which analysis by occupational categories were not available.

For an explanation of the terms used in the publication refer to the July - September 1970 report.

PART A

Agency Corporations, Proprietary Corporations and
Other Agencies and Corporations

The number of employees within this category was 135.9 thousand at the end of December 1970 with a gross payroll of \$304 million for the three month period.

Compared to employment at the end of September 1970, there was a decrease of 5.5 thousand. Gross payroll for the quarter were \$9.6 million less than the previous quarter.

The decrease in both numbers employed and gross payroll occurred mainly within the Canadian National Railway System.

Comparable data for the same period of the previous year are not available.

PART B

Departments and Departmental Corporations

The total number of employees in this category was 243.0 thousand at the end of December 1970 and represented an increase of 5.8 thousand over the total at the end of September 1970.

Total payroll for the quarter amounted to \$466.9 million, an increase of \$6.1 million over the previous quarter.

Comparable data for the same period in the previous year are not available.


HIRINGS AND SEPARATIONS

Notes and Definitions

Data on hirings and separations were first published in the Federal Government Employment report for December 1959 and covered the quarter October 1 to December 31, 1959. This table records hiring and separation averages by department.

Each "department" is considered for purposes of turnover statistics as a separate employing agency. Consequently, movements of personnel between "departments" are treated in the same way as movements into and out of the government service. The aggregate hirings and separations are summed up in "Total - all departments". It should be noted, therefore, that hiring and separation data for the entire Government of Canada as an employer cannot be secured from this table.

It should also be noted that the totals shown in this table differ from hiring and separation data published by the Public Service Commission of Canada. The latter organization treats all staff employed under the authority of the Public Service Employment Act as a complete unit and consequently is concerned only with movements into and out of "Act" employment. The Commission therefore is not concerned with inter-departmental movements of employees, but, with movements of staff to and from "Act" employment even when such movements occur within a department.



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
