INTRODUCTION

For a complete description of the method of collection and statistics included in this series reference may be had to the report for April, 1957.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER QUASI-INDEPENDENT GOVERNMENT BODIES

Employment and earnings reported in table 1 summarizes the record of these organizations for the months shown.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS

The main change occurring in this group resulted from the general salary increase granted to most classes of salaried employees in the service effective May 1st 1957. Comparison with earlier earnings data for "Salaried" employees will indicate the effect of the increase. Most increases in numbers and earnings of Prevailing Rate and Casual staffs resulted from normal seasonal increases in these classes of employment by the various departments.
