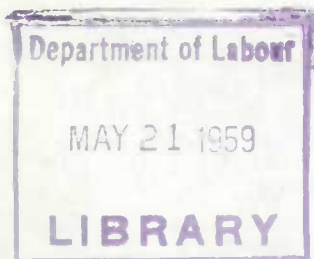

INTRODUCTION

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given in the report for April, 1958. Wherever possible the numbers of persons employed, as published in this report, are based on a count of the number on strength on the final day of the month. In some cases published reports of departments and corporations give a count of the number of persons paid during the final pay period or on strength on the final pay day in the month and hence they may not agree with data shown in this publication.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER QUASI-INDEPENDENT  
GOVERNMENT BODIES

Table 1 summarizes the record of employment of these organizations for the months shown. The decrease of 4,100 employees between September and October is accounted for by Canadian National Railways and the Northern Transportation Company.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS

Table 2 shows revised data for August and September in order that the result of including National Defence department data for those months might be recorded. Between July and October the Army recorded a drop of over 2,000 prevailing rate employees mainly in August and September. Army also showed a decline of almost 1,100 casualties in the same period while Air services recorded over 500 fewer casualties in October compared with July. These changes all affect the function - Defence Services.

Comparison of revised September statistics with those for October shows a small decline in Salaried employment due mainly to the return of Student Assistants to school. The drop in prevailing rates staff occurred mainly in the Defence Services, Recreational and Cultural Services and National Resources and Primary Industries functions and reflected seasonal layoffs. Increases in casual employment occurred in several functions, the largest gains being in Transportation and Communications - Waterways and Natural Resources and Primary Industries - Lands.
