

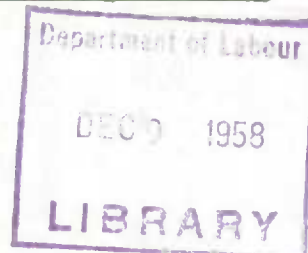

INTRODUCTION

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given in the report for April, 1958. Wherever possible the numbers of persons employed, as published in this report, are based on a count of the number on strength on the final day of the month. In some cases published reports of departments and corporations give a count of the number of persons paid during the final pay period or on strength on the final pay day in the month and hence they may not agree with data shown in this publication.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER QUASI-INDEPENDENT
GOVERNMENT BODIES

Table 1 summarizes the record of employment of these organizations for the months shown.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS

Salaried employment increased seasonally in several departments as did prevailing rate and casual employment. Agriculture, Fisheries, Mines and Technical Surveys, National Defence and Public Works all reported such changes. The Senate and House of Commons staffs were increased sharply due to the opening of the 24th Parliament which commenced sessions during the month. Northern Affairs and National Resources had seasonal increases in salaried employment but declines in prevailing rate and casual staff owing to the completion of the departments' special winter program designed to alleviate unemployment. Transport also indicated a gain in salaried and a drop in casual employment.
