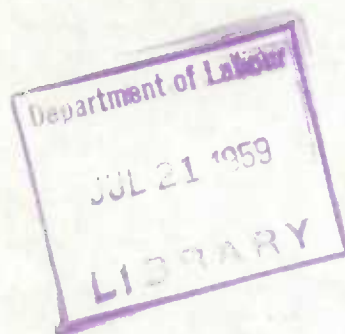

## FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

February, 1959

INTRODUCTION

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given in the report for April, 1958. Wherever possible the numbers of persons employed, as published in this report, are based on a count of the number on strength on the final day of the month. In some cases published reports of departments and corporations give a count of the number of persons paid during the final pay period or on strength on the final pay day in the month and hence they may not agree with data shown in this publication.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER QUASI-INDEPENDENT  
GOVERNMENT BODIES

The strike of some 1,150 Canadian Broadcasting Corporation employees which commenced on December 29th continued throughout February with a resultant loss of between \$350,000 and \$400,000 earnings for the month.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS

Staff of the Board of Broadcast Governors is reported for the first time. The Board was established under authority of an Order-In-Council dated January 21, 1959. Salaried employment showed a seasonal increase of 464 in the function General Government - Executive and administrative. Prevailing Rate employees were reduced 196 in number in the function Recreational and Cultural Services - Parks etc. Casual employment showed considerable fluctuation with increases mainly in Defence Services (+ 139) and Natural Resources - Fish and Game (+ 60) and Lands, Settlement and Agriculture (+ 136). These increases were more than offset by major declines in Transportation and Communications - Waterways (- 458) and Airways (- 71); Social Welfare - National Employment Service (- 478) and Natural Resources and Primary Industries - Other (- 88).

Total regular employment (182,205) was 1.4 p.c. higher than in February, 1958 and 5.5 p.c. above February, 1957 (172,708).
